

NEW TENANTS IN JUNE:

Our church has signed a new long-term lease commencing June 1! Assist, our current tenant, will be with us until May 31. Our new tenant is the Hope Academy of the Marconi Montessori School. They will operate a day care and preschool up to 5 years of age and use all our educational facilities. One benefit of this lease is the positive financial impact on our church - we do not need to pursue selling our field with this lease in place. The contract with Coldwell Banker to find a buyer for our field has been discontinued. Please keep the Montessori School and T&C in your prayers as our new tenant settles in and works to setup and fill their new school on our campus.

In a few short days, all Christendom will again journey in memory through the days of Holy Week, remembering the closing events of Christ's earthly ministry. In thoughtfully reading the accounts of that Passion Week, we are struck by the voices: the shouts, cries, charges, counter-charges, denials, and promises. Spend a few silent moments as we listen to the voices:

The voices of the triumphant welcome:

"Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

The voice of bargaining: "What will you give me if I deliver Him to you?"

The voice of question: "Is it I, Lord?"

The voice of self-confidence: "Even though they all fall away, I will not."

The voice of the traitor: "Hail, master!"

The harsh voice: "I do not know this man of whom you speak!"

The cruel voices: "Prophesy! Who is it that struck you?!

The unreasonable voice: "Away with this man and release to us Barabbas!"

The frenzied mob voices: "Crucify Him! Crucify Him!"

The mocking voices: "He saved others, He cannot save Himself."

Voices of Jerusalem: unkind, unjust, unloving. But listen again...

"If anyone serves me, the Father will honor him."

"I have come as light into the world, that whoever believes in me may not remain in darkness."

"By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

"I am the way and the truth and the life; no one comes to the Father, but by me."

"This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you."

"Whom seek ye?"

"It is finished."
