Most of their possessions are either being left in Hawaii or arriving by boat by mid-August. We thought a few items for the apartment or gift cards to grocery, department stores or restaurants would be helpful as well. Orphan Grain Train Sends Shipment to Ghana:

The Orphan Grain Train's (OGT) New England Branch, located in Terryville, CT. loaded a 40 foot container of needed items for Ghana on June 8, 2018. This is the nineteenth shipment since the Branch was dedicated as the 23rd in the country for OGT on June of 2014. OGT has the use of a warehouse in Terryville that is owned by Mr. Bill Allread who has made space available for this charitable work.

The Ghana shipment included many medical items such as 21 hospital beds, over 100 walkers and 130 canes, 5 neonatal cribs, 31 wheelchairs, Hygiene kits, Layette kits, and hundreds of boxes of medical supplies and clothing. More than 20 volunteers worked at the warehouse to complete the loading that also took hundreds of volunteer hours to pick up items and sort, pack and box what was required for shipment.

Other shipments have gone to a number of countries e.g. Liberia, Nicaragua, Ukraine, Moldova, Lithuania, Latvia, Liberia, Nepal, the Philippines, Puerto Rico, and the Republic of Georgia. The Branch also helps those locally, giving medical items that have been donated to individuals in need and thru the visiting nurse and hospice care organizations of the area. It has also helped with a shipment to the Bridgeport Rescue Mission.

The effort is an Outreach Ministry of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, and OGT is a 501(3)(C) charity affiliated with the church and supported locally by Holy Trinity Lutheran in Terryville and Immanuel Lutheran in Bristol and is open to all who want to help others.
