**FIRST READING** Colossians 1:1-14 (Delivered, transferred, redeemed, forgiven.)

<sup>1</sup> Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother,

<sup>2</sup> To the saints and faithful brothers in Christ at Colossae:

Grace to you and peace from God our Father.

<sup>3</sup> We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you,  
<sup>4</sup> since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and of the love that you have for all the saints,  
<sup>5</sup> because of the hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel,  
<sup>6</sup> which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and increasing—as it also does among you, since the day you heard it and understood the grace of God in truth,  
<sup>7</sup> just as you learned it from Epaphras our beloved fellow servant. He is a faithful minister of Christ on your behalf  
<sup>8</sup> and has made known to us your love in the Spirit.

<sup>9</sup> And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,  
<sup>10</sup> so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;  
<sup>11</sup> being strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy;  
<sup>12</sup> giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in light.  
<sup>13</sup> He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son,  
<sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

**SECOND READING**    Luke 10:1-12, 17-20 (Jesus sends out the seventy-two.)

<sup>1</sup> After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them on ahead of Him, two by two, into every town and place where He Himself was about to go.  
<sup>2</sup> And He said to them, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.  
<sup>3</sup> Go your way; behold, I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves.  
<sup>4</sup> Carry no moneybag, no knapsack, no sandals, and greet no one on the road.  
<sup>5</sup> Whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace be to this house!’  
<sup>6</sup> And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest upon him. But if not, it will return to you.  
<sup>7</sup> And remain in the same house, eating and drinking what they provide, for the laborer deserves his wages. Do not go from house to house.  
<sup>8</sup> Whenever you enter a town and they receive you, eat what is set before you.  
<sup>9</sup> Heal the sick in it and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’  
<sup>10</sup> But whenever you enter a town and they do not receive you, go into its streets and say,  
<sup>11</sup> ‘Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet we wipe off against you. Nevertheless know this, that the kingdom of God has come near.’  
<sup>12</sup> I tell you, it will be more bearable on that day for Sodom than for that town. ...

<sup>17</sup>The seventy-two returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in your name!" <sup>18</sup>And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. <sup>19</sup>Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you. <sup>20</sup>Nevertheless, do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."
