### LIGHTING OF THE PASCHAL CANDLE

For 40 days, the praises of God's people have been subdued, symbolized by burying our "Alleluia's," and by mourning the sin that brought about Jesus' death. But now Jesus is alive! And so for the next 40 days the Paschal candle will burn to remind us that Jesus was visibly present for this long before He ascended into heaven.

From the Latin word "Pascha", the Paschal candle relates to the ultimate mystery of our salvation. The candle used in worship, sometimes referred to as the "Christ candle," is lit each Sunday of Easter until the Feast of the Ascension, symbolizing Christ's departure to heaven. Following the Ascension, the candle is relit at every Baptism and funeral, thus symbolizing the gift of new life in Jesus that comes to us through. Through God's gift of life in Christ, He will welcome His children home.



**EPISTLE READING** 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 (Our resurrection hope.)

<sup>1</sup> Now I would remind you, brothers, of the gospel I preached to you, which you received, in which you stand, <sup>2</sup> and by which you are being saved, if you hold fast to the word I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.

<sup>3</sup> For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, <sup>5</sup> and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. <sup>6</sup> Then He appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep. <sup>7</sup> Then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles. <sup>8</sup> Last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared also to me. <sup>9</sup> For I am the least of the apostles, unworthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. <sup>10</sup> But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain. On the contrary, I worked harder than any of them, though it was not I, but the grace of God that is with me. <sup>11</sup> Whether then it was I or they, so we preach and so you believed.

<sup>1</sup>Now on the first day of the week Mary Magdalene came to the tomb early, while it was still dark, and saw that the stone had been taken away from the tomb. <sup>2</sup> So she ran and went to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one whom Jesus loved, and said to them, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him." <sup>3</sup> So Peter went out with the other disciple, and they were going toward the tomb. <sup>4</sup> Both of them were running together, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first. <sup>5</sup> And stooping to look in, he saw the linen cloths lying there, but he did not go in. <sup>6</sup> Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb. 
### PROPER PREFACE


