**OLD TESTAMENT READING** Isaiah 5:1-7 (The vineyard of the Lord.)

<sup>1</sup> Let me sing for my beloved my love song concerning his vineyard: My beloved had a vineyard on a very fertile hill.

- <sup>3</sup> And now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem and men of Judah, judge between me and my vineyard.
- <sup>4</sup> What more was there to do for my vineyard, that I have not done in it? When I looked for it to yield grapes, why did it yield wild grapes?

# "Getting to Know Trinity"


