

"HEAR THE WORD OF THE LORD"

NOTES ON OUR GOSPEL: Christ Jesus Is the Sabbath Rest that Remains for the People of God Forevermore. The Lord brought the sons of Israel out of Egypt "with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm," in order to give them rest (Deut. 5:15). When He commanded them to "observe the Sabbath day," therefore, it meant not doing "any work" but resting in His works (Deut. 5:12, 14). So has the same Lord, Jesus Christ, come in the flesh to fulfill the Law and to become our Sabbath Rest. As David "entered the house of God," and not only "ate the bread of the Presence" but "also gave it to those who were with him" (Mark 2:26), the Lord Jesus entered the Holy of Holies as our great High Priest, in order to feed us with His flesh as the true bread of the Presence of God. As "lord even of the Sabbath," He works "to do good," to heal and "to save life" (Mark 2:28; 3:2, 4). He brings us out of sin and death and gives us rest in His own crucified and risen body. Though it is given "in jars of clay," the life of Jesus is thereby manifested in our bodies (2 Cor. 4:7–11).

STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS: June 3 (Proper 4). 2 Corinthians 4:7 – "But we have this treasure in jars of clay, to show that the surpassing power belongs to God and not to us." The chief treasure we have is our faith – our connection to Jesus and all the blessings He bestows upon us: forgiveness of sins, the Holy Spirit, new desires to follow Him, spiritual growth into His image, etc. St. Paul says we have these treasures in jars of clay – that is, of ourselves we are still weak, stumbling, and powerless. The treasure is not us, but what the Lord has graciously given us. We are vessels for His blessings. But a treasure horded is a treasure wasted. How is the Lord calling you to share these and all the treasures He has given you?

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT MISSION OFFERINGS

- 1. Our current annual budgeted pledge to the Southern Illinois District for mission support is \$19,000.
- A number of years ago the Voter's made the decision to send the actual amount collected to S.I.D. as opposed to the budgeted pledge.
- 3. In 2017 mission contributions exceeded \$24,000 which was the first time contributions had exceeded the pledge.
- 4. Currently there is no alternative to the S.I.D. as a recipient of mission contributions.
- Member fees for the Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School Assn. have risen steadily since the school came into being. These fees are based upon the communicant membership of the member congregations.
- A proposal has been brought forward to utilize any mission offerings in excess of our annual pledge to the S.I.D. to offset a portion of our annual commitment to CORLHS.
- Any change to the manner in which mission offerings are distributed would be implemented in the 2018 giving year.

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT OFFICE RENOVATION PHASE II

- 1. Trustees overview is in this bulletin.
- 2. Phase II consists of the renovation of the area commonly referred to as Miss Cheryl's office.
- 3. Numerous financial pledges and commitments are in place to offset the cost of completing this project.
