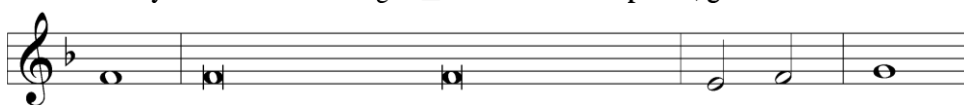

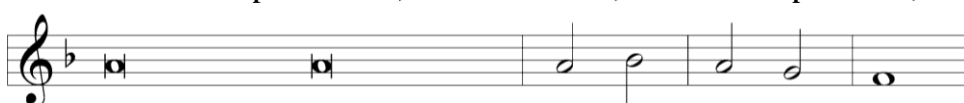

Suppose twenty are found there.” He answered, “For the sake of twenty I will not destroy it.” ³²Then he said, “Oh let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak again but this once. 



Games will be played after the meeting.

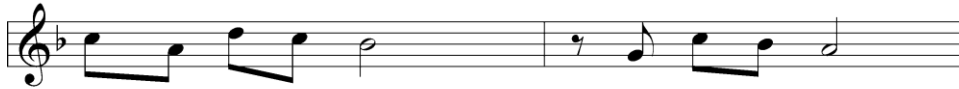

For this year's Savers Drive we will accept some added items.

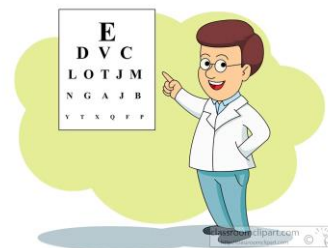
Soft goods (clothing, shoes, purses, rugs, etc.) will need to be placed in 13-gallon bags.

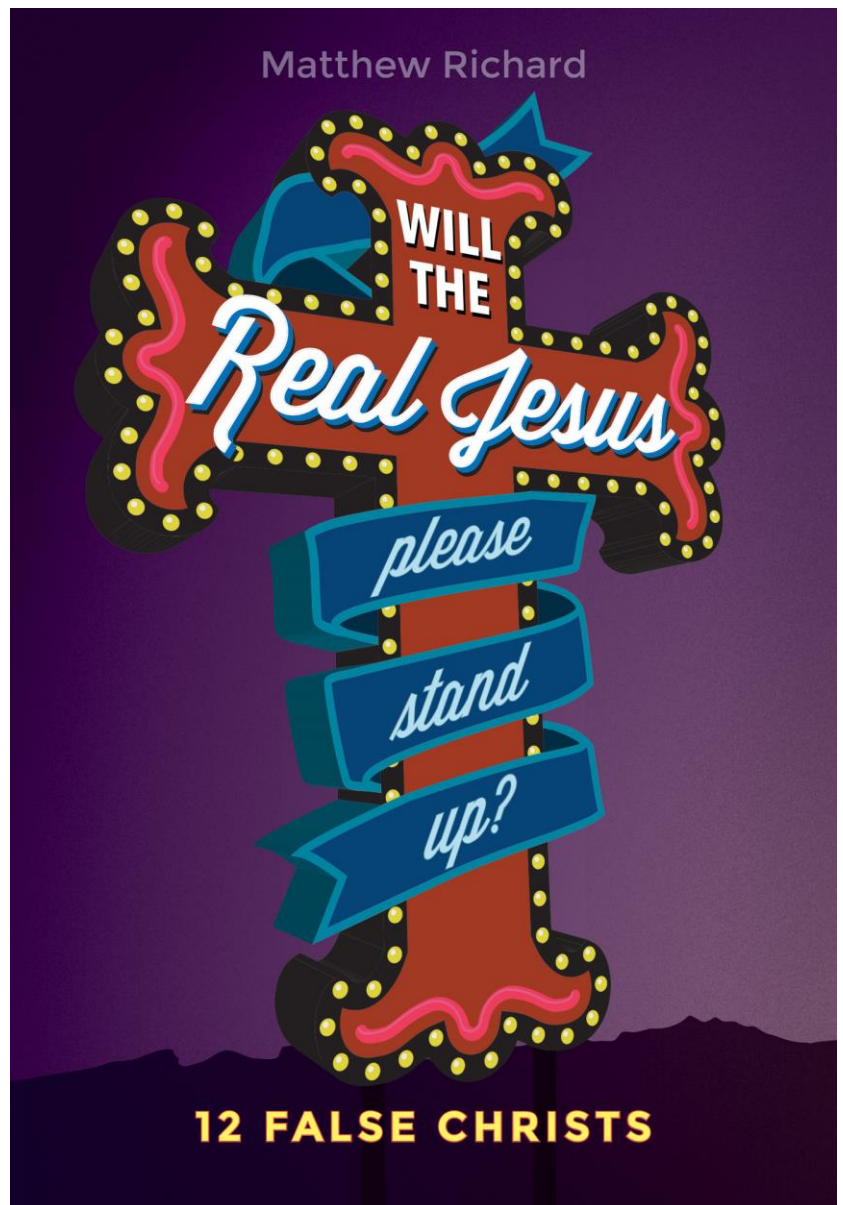
