





"TELL THE GOOD NEWS FEARLESSLY!"

This is the theme for a multigenerational workshop put on by Ongoing Ambassadors for Christ (OAFC) at Trinity Lutheran Church, Hoffman, IL, on Saturday, August 9, 2025. The theme is based on Isaiah 40:9, "Go on up to a high mountain, O Zion, herald of good news; lift up your voice with strength, O Jerusalem, herald of good news; lift it up, fear not; say to the cities of Judah, 'Behold your God!'"

We will begin at 9:00 a.m. and conclude by attending the 6:00 p.m. worship service at Trinity. The purpose of the day is for youth and adults to gain confidence in sharing their faith by doing it.




