**Sunday School 2020-2021 COVID-19 Procedures**

Sunday School for the 2020-2021 year will take place in person, socially distanced, from 10am-10:45am each Sunday.

A survey was sent to parents in the middle of August asking their preference for Sunday School. We received an overwhelming response in favor of holding Sunday School in person while socially distanced and wearing masks. Because of this – the following protocols will be in place:

- If a student is feeling sick or have a fever – please stay at home.
- If you or someone in your family has been exposed to the virus within the last two weeks, for the health and safety of all, we ask that you do not attend.
- Surfaces will be wiped down and sanitized in every classroom each week.
- Masks will be required to be worn throughout the Sunday School time.
  - For those under 5, masks are encouraged
- Classrooms will be set up to encourage social distancing.
- Hand sanitizer will be in each room and used frequently.
- Classrooms will have no more than 6 students and 1-2 teachers.

If we receive notification that someone has tested positive within our congregation or Sunday School we will notify those in attendance of a positive test – keeping the identity of the individual confidential.

The Board of Education and Church Council are constantly monitoring the situation and will make changes necessary for the safety and health of everyone. We are using the recommendations of local school districts as our guide.

Students in PreK – 1<sup>st</sup> grade will meet in the Sanctuary from 10:05-10:20am for an opening consisting of songs, an intro to the Bible story, offering, and other information to share with the kids. Students in 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade will meet in the Sanctuary from 10:30-10:45am for a closing consisting of the same things as the opening, just age appropriate for older kids.

If you choose to drop off your child/ren please wait with them in their classroom until their teacher is present. We do not want students dropped off with no teacher in the room.

This year we are providing a small snack for students in PreK-1<sup>st</sup> grade at the start of Sunday School in their classrooms. If your child has any diet restrictions or allergies, please let Emmalee know.

We pray for a safe and healthy year as we continue to learn and grow in faith.
