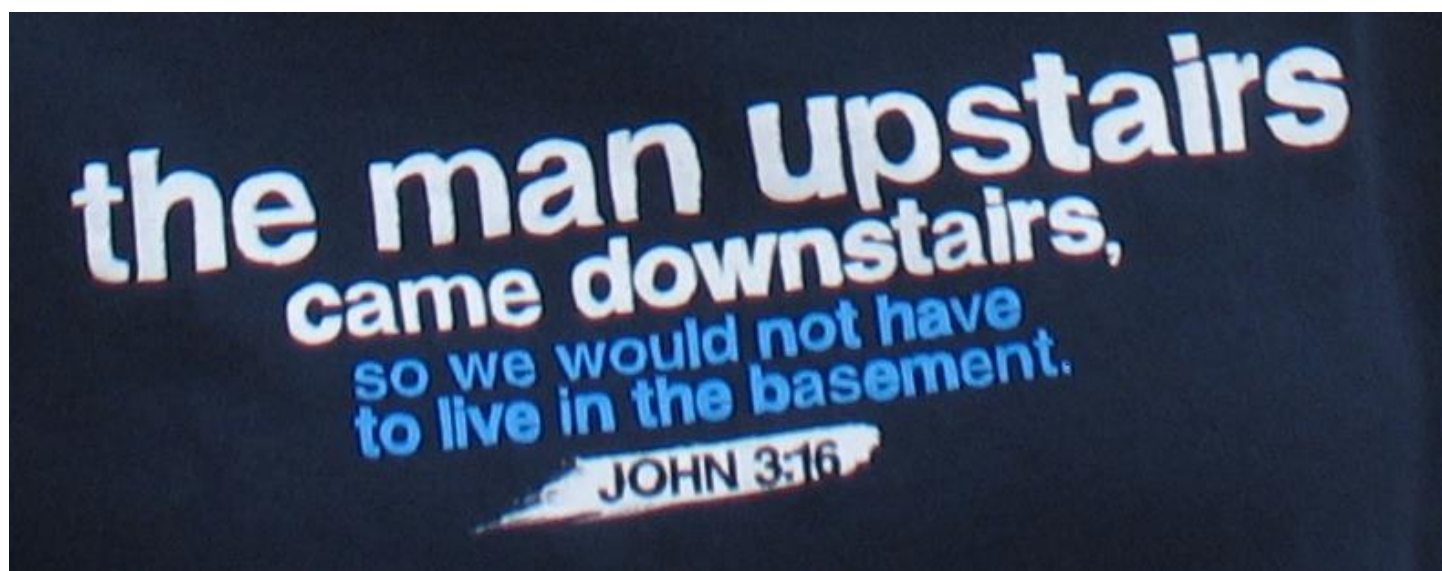

Our \$500 Mission Dollars for November goes to: Armed Forces Ministry of the LCMS.

The LCMS Ministry to the Armed Forces supports almost 200 chaplains, who represent the church on active duty, the reserves, the National Guard, and Civil Air Patrol. Chaplains meet the needs of military personnel and their families. The LCMS cares deeply for those who currently serve, for those who have donned the cloth of our nation in uniform, and for those who served our nation and live in our communities.

We pray that Pastor's surgery was a great success and he will be out of pain. Also, a big thanks to Pastor and his committees who have creatively made it possible to worship each Sunday with God's grace and love.

As was expected, the congregation generously donated to Matt Talbot Kitchen. We received \$300. The donations to the Bennett food pantry from the beginning of the year to the end of October was \$337 cash, 640 food items, 32 clothing items, 41 health items, and 2 baby items.

October 4th, Mary Jo attended the LWML Fall Rally at Redeemer.

The first two Sunday's in November, will once again be time to collect and send a donation to the City Mission. The Mission has been serving the Lincoln community by bringing the good news of Jesus Christ to the poor and homeless, and demonstrating His love for them by meeting basic human needs. In the 113 years since it was founded, more than 500,000 people have been assisted by their ministry. Last year over 30,000 people were served, 224,000 meals were served, 17,000 people were helped at their Free Clinic and 1.14 million pounds of food was given away.

A thank you to Pastor Holtzen for making the sneeze guard for the kitchen serving line. Materials were paid for by Mary and Martha League.
