## **A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR HOFFMAN**

“Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel”  
(Which means, God With Us) Matthew 1:23

### **EIGHT MILES**

Eight miles is the distance from Bethlehem to Jerusalem. As we approach the birth of Jesus Christ into the world this Advent season, we focus on Bethlehem, where our Lord, the Son of God was born. The trip to Israel was so rich and amazing that it is still soaking in, and our visit to Bethlehem was surreal. There, as with most of the holy sites around Israel, was a church constructed near the site, the Church of the Nativity, where we saw a cave where animals were kept in Jesus' day. Of course it probably isn't the exact location of Jesus' birth but it was near, and that is significant.



What was even more significant was that shortly after Jesus' birth his life was threatened by King Herod in neighboring Jerusalem. After being warned in a dream, Joseph, Mary and the baby fled to Egypt. But year's later Jerusalem would be the site where Jesus would be put on trial and sentenced to be crucified...just eight miles from where He was born, Jesus would meet His death, and by so doing He would pay the penalty incurred by every living human being through His death on a cross. More importantly, just outside of Jerusalem, Jesus came back to life, defeating sin, death, and the power of the devil for you and me.

That is Christmas, Easter, and all of the other church seasons summed up. Jesus Christ has risen! That wonderful story started to unfold from the very beginning of creation and is now coming to the part where our Messiah, our Immanuel comes to us. Joy and peace to you and your family this season where blessings flow and Gospel of Jesus Christ stands!

### Mission Musings



#### CHRIST'S CARE FOR CHILDREN: KENYA

The Missions Committee has been studying missionary or mission project adoption for the coming year. We studied 120 LCMS worldwide mission opportunities and unanimously voted to adopt **CHRIST'S CARE FOR CHILDREN: KENYA**.

The 3 boarding schools want to expand and offer more help to more of the poorest of the poor children. The facilities are available for children of primary school age who live some distance from adequate schools. These children have been identified by the Lutheran Church of Kenya as unable to receive a level of care at home that is conducive to their studies including household responsibilities like tending animals, fetching water, helping care for siblings, or preparing meals. The Lutheran school will provide a safe environment, adequate lodging, meals, school fees and related school expenses, medical care, safe play area, adult oversight, scholastic tutoring, emotional support and most important **SPIRITUAL CARE AND INSTRUCTION**.

Each student will be taught regular studies, daily Bible Study, worship services and given an opportunity in their lives to grow in faith to celebrate Christ and understand they are saved by grace through faith in our Lord Jesus, as pointed out in Ephesians 2:8-9

The need for these schools is great among the poorest of the poor people in these areas. The students are eager to learn, but families have no resources to send their children to a school like this.

### Lutheran Women in Mission



As we begin the new year, we remember our Lutheran Women in Mission motto "Serve the Lord with gladness" (Psalm 100:2). We look back on glad times and forward to the opportunities 2018 will offer us. We encourage all the women of Trinity to join us and help us as we reach out to others with the Great Commission.

- ♦ Sunday, January 7th, we will have a meeting at church between the services in one of the classrooms to plan the new activities for the year.
- ♦ January 14- February 14th we will collect items for the Pregnancy Center in Elgin. We are asking the congregation for diapers of all sizes, paper towels, toilet tissue, and baby wipes. There will be a box for these items plainly marked at church. The Center services women and their babies in Elgin, Algonquin, and the surrounding area.
- ♦ March until end of the year we are collecting used and broken eye-glasses , frames and cases for use overseas, where they are repaired for the on-going vision ministry. We also collect stamps for missions - stamps that are unusual are trimmed from letters and sold to collectors to fund mission projects.
- ♦ It has been suggested that we plan a Spring Social Gathering - such as a salad luncheon .
- ♦ The LWML wishes to continue to serve the coffee at church the first Sunday of every month.

There will be more about our projects later in the year, but always remember that the Mites collected the first Sunday of each month in church are used to fund mission projects all over the world. Please see the bulletin board by the office for the list of those projects.

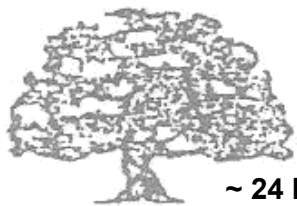
