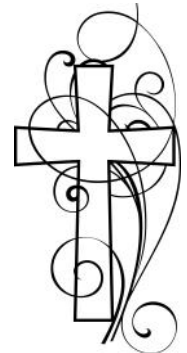
The result of the Voters' Meeting on May 6th was 87-14 in favor of the Capital Campaign by LCEF.

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR HOFFMAN



Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord, nor of me his prisoner, but share in suffering for the gospel by the power of God, who saved us and called us to a holy calling, not because of our works but because of his own purpose and grace, which he gave us in Christ Jesus before the ages began, and which now has been manifested through the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel. 2 Timothy 1:8-10

I remember growing up and hearing my dad complain about having to pay taxes, the problems with the government, the weather, and how the church wanted him to give more money. One day, I became an adult and I complained about taxes, problems with the government, the weather, and work (I didn't complain about giving at church because I wasn't attending church when I was younger). Complaining becomes a way of life only because it's so easy to pass it on to your children. Complaining chokes and smothers the Spirit that you received from baptism so that you don't follow the Lord. Complaining is a serious and life-threatening issue, spiritual and physical.

In the above text it tells us that we are called to a holy life, not a complaining one, because of God's purpose and grace for us, not because we did anything to deserve it. Think about it, we really haven't given much of anything without some hesitation or grumbling and when we're asked to dig deeper the deeper our complaint. Whereas Jesus gave and gave and gave and gave without hesitation. Jesus gave orders; he gave authority to heal and cast out demons; he gave loaves and fish to hungry people; he gave permission; he gave blessings; he gave time for repentance; he gave his body and his life; he gave his flesh and blood.

Our Father gave us the universe; the moon and the stars; the planet earth; oceans and lakes; land; fish; animals; all people; air; the seasons; food; and everything to support this body and life. And what have we given? Our Lord still cares for us and still wants his Church to preach and teach, to baptize, and catechize Christ crucified. It is an imperative, to share the message of the Good News of Jesus Christ with all people no matter what their response is. The joy that we have, the forgiveness that we receive, and the life-everlasting that awaits us gives us the Spirit-filled motivation to stop complaining and start praising our Lord for His grace and mercy.

Ask the Lord to relieve your burdens and the handicaps that are holding you back from receiving more than you could ever imagine. And take hold of the life that God called you to have, one that is holy and set apart from the world, and pass that on to your children and grandchildren. Looking forward to the future of Christ's church at Trinity praise be to God in the highest.

GARY'S DOXOLOGY REPORT



Stewardship - Let's take a look at where we are at.

Hello Trinity, previously I reported what Pastor Meador had told us about **most** Missouri Synod Churches, not really looking at stewardship, only paying the bills. He said most churches needed a stewardship transformation. He also said that there were few who understood, and were generous with all their gifts, such as, forgiveness, talents, time and money. They understand through scripture, that is what God expects them to do. They looked toward the future care of God's church. This was done for future generations, just as past generations have done for them.

I would say that Trinity has begun its transformation. The church has recognized and analyzed the building situation. We put a plan together to work toward a solution to a wide variety of issues. Together we took tours and educated ourselves to what the issues are and the importance of them. Then, together we voted overwhelmingly to continue on. Putting faith first, but yet with the fear of the unknown. Putting God's word and expectations of us first, yet with anxiety of how **we** can make this happen. That's the key, **we** can 't make this happen, but **God** can. He has proven time and time again what can be accomplished when we have enough faith to begin. Just start, have faith in God, and pray. Let's let him show us what he has in store for us.

We have already started, and I know there is a lot of hard work and soul searching ahead of us. For today, take joy and happiness that you are part of a church family that hears Gods word and call, and we are beginning a new way to answer it. I believe Trinity is becoming one of those churches that Pastor Meador says **"Get's It"**. I am so excited to see what God has in store for Trinity. 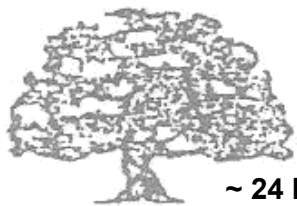
