Matthew 28:1-10

The end of the Lord's Prayer has the perfect words for one for E \_\_\_\_\_.

Today we celebrate Jesus' resurrection P \_\_\_\_\_ and G \_\_\_\_\_.

**POWER** *"O Lord my God, when I in awesome wonder consider all the works Thy hands hath made, I see the stars, I hear the mighty thunder, Thy power throughout the universe displayed. . . . How great Thou art!" LSB 801:1*

On Easter morning there was a violent e \_\_\_\_\_. When the Lord speaks and acts, you better take notice. (The earth had rumbled also at 3:00 pm on the previous Friday.)

    - 2.They not just bring out the body of Jesus and display it for all to see?
    - 3.So many over the years be willing to die for a lie?
- ⇒ HE IS RISEN! HE IS RISEN, INDEED!

**GLORY** Glory can be temporary and it can be lasting.

- ⇒ The Black Hills Passion Play in Lake Wales Florida. The b \_\_\_\_\_ light from the empty tomb. Hurricane Charley destroyed the outdoor theatre.
- ⇒ King David in all his glory... 1 Chronicles 29 and preparation for glorious temple in Jerusalem. The Babylonians came and destroyed this beautiful temple in \_\_\_\_\_ BC.
- ⇒ The Transfiguration is the last Sunday before Lent. The Lord pulls back His humanity and lets us see His d\_\_\_\_\_ glory.
- ⇒ Palm Sunday sing, "All Glory, Laud and Honor."
- ⇒ Easter Sunday..... very quiet when Jesus came back. Even that night when He appeared to the disciples, quietly says, "Peace be with you." Come and see and feel my hands, feet and side. "It's Me." B \_\_\_\_\_!
- ⇒ Jesus has gone from death to life. The tomb is empty!
- ⇒ John 13:31-32. "Now is the Son of Man g\_\_\_\_\_ and God is glorified in him."
