BOARD OF CHRISTIAN EDUCATION: Missy Erath announced that Sunday school will be completed on May 17th. VBS is planned for June - many volunteers needed. The VBS committee will meet after Easter. The small group bible studies are still meeting.

<u>BOARD OF EVANGELISM:</u> JR Westberg announced that we will participate in the farmer's market. Volunteers needed. JR and Marilee Payne will meet to discuss mission outreach.

BOARD OF PARISH FELLOWSHIP: no report

BOARD OF PUBLIC RELATIONS: no report

<u>BOARD OF STEWARDSHIP</u>: Lou Ann Jensen noted that we have received \$195 in "J" dollars (serial # starting with "J") and \$700 in "Needs Tree" donations.

<u>BOARD OF TRUSTEES:</u> Jerry Nepermann reported that there will be spring cleanup days for inside and out. Volunteers needed.

BOARD OF YOUNG PEOPLE'S WORK: Nancy Dvorak reported that she, member Adriaan Vrugt and the 7th & 8th graders went to WalCamp the last weekend in February and had a very good time. She announced that the Easter breakfast will be between 7-8 am. The next Culver's Night will be April 13th.

<u>TLC PRESCHOOL</u>: Janice Krawczak reported that spring break is next week and announced that the Tom's Flower fundraiser pick-up date is May 16th.

MISSIONS COMMITTEE: Marilee Payne explained that there are 3 outreaches: Trinity, Community and World. Meals will be prepared and delivered for those returning home from the hospital and rehab as well as to for shut-ins on holidays. College-age members receive monthly packages containing Portals of Prayer, cookies, etc.; the parish nursing program offers blood pressure screening the 3rd Sunday; a grief group has been meeting; quilts are given to those in hospital, Home of the Sparrow & Bethesda; we contribute to the food drive for the food pantry. The on-going project for the Elgin Pregnancy Center ends with a "baby shower" on May 16th. A joint effort, with Shepherd of the Prairie, to clean up the landscaping at Green Trees of Huntley, McHenry Co. housing is planned as well as spring clean-up at WalCamp. Our next Feed my Starving Children volunteer day will be in June. Signup is on bulletin board in Narthex. A Missions Fair is scheduled for April after services.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u>: Marilee Payne inquired about the need of an elevator. Jim answered that it is being discussed. He suggested that we kick off a "building fund" drive.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: The nomination committee for the 2015-2017 officer and board elections will be Anne Boho, Rick Payne, Larry Melman, Gary Schultze, John Drafall, Lou Ann Jensen and Pastor Hoffman. The ballot will be posted at least 3 wks prior to the elections during May voters meeting.

Culver's was thanked for providing Trinity with bags for the Easter egg hunt.


The Galloping Horses Quilters have donated a quantity of their beautiful baby quilts to this project.


