Dear Saints,

For the next few months, I'm going to reflect on famous works of Christian art. Art can be a powerful vessel for the Christian story, causing us to ponder what God has done for us in Jesus. In fact, for thousands of years, art was one of the main avenues for average men and women to understand the good news of Jesus.

As Luther once said, "Pictures [...] we would paint on walls for the sake of remembrance and better understanding. [...] God desires to have his works heard and read, especially the passion of our Lord. But it is impossible for me to hear and bear it in mind without forming mental images of it in my heart. a cross takes form in my heart. [...] If it is not a sin but good to have the

For whether I will or not, when I hear of Christ, an image of a man hanging on image of Christ in my heart, why should it be a sin to have it in my eyes?" (AE: 40, 85-100).

This first painting stands above the altar of St. Peter and Paul church in Weimar, Germany. Painted by Lucas Cranach (1472-1553) and completed by his son in 1555, it depicts the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus, along with the subsequent justification of the believer.

To the right of the crucified Jesus stand John the Baptist, Lucas Cranach (the painter of this piece), and Martin Luther. John the Baptist points to Jesus, "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29). Blood from Jesus' side lands on Cranach's head, indicating his sins have been forgiven. His hands are folded reverently in a posture of faith, receiving this wonderful gift. Luther, points to the Word of God, the final authority of the Christian faith. On the left side of the painting, the risen Jesus stands victorious over both death and the devil, which he impales with a spear.

BOARD OF MINISTRY DIRECTORS by Ken Ladage, Chairman

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

May Jesus Christ be praised, He is risen, alleluia. May what we do, may what we say and may what we write lead to praise of him who redeemed us, who brought the "Good News" of salvation to the entire world.

Reverend Doctor Allan Buss, President of the Northern Illinois District, stated that during his presidency, the one thing everything we do will serve is "keeping the main thing the main thing" faithfully serving the Gospel of Jesus Christ and sharing it in our community and the world".

As I prepared this Newsletter my thought was how quickly time flies by, we are into November and almost to Thanksgiving. The Pam Kahl Memorial Scholarship dinner will be held November 5th. Also watch for information regarding the Adopt a Family Christmas Gift Tree.

A Congregational Voters Meeting was held on October 9th and several business items were discussed and approved. The Congregation approved the Board of Ministry Directors Nomination Committee, chaired by Keith Bereolos, including committee members Solomon Post, Larry Melman and Janet Westberg. Church members are encouraged to nominate individuals for the Board. However, before nominating an individual, please obtain their agreement to serve. The Board elections will occur during a Voters Meeting scheduled on December 4th at 9:15am. If you have any questions, contact a committee member. The Assembly also authorized the Board of Ministry Directors to enter into an agreement with Enrique Castel's Architectural Firm for services for Trinity's addition and interior remodeling.

After the business meeting was adjourned, a town hall meeting was held to discuss the various building options currently under review. When the plans and costs estimates are completed, the Congregation will have options to discuss and approve. Contact the Church Office and a copy of the current plans will be e-mailed to you.

Pastor has 10 students in confirmation class, and 10 individuals in the new member class. Church attendance continues to increase year to date.

The Church Security Committee is reviewing our preparedness to handle injuries in the Preschool or Church. We need to increase our stock of medical supplies and provide appropriate training for their use. The emergency supplies must be suitable for treating both adults and children. Options will be considered for obtaining these supplies and training. Other areas of review have included the status of fire extinguishers and clearly marking their locations. Plans for the building additions will also be reviewed for security considerations.

The Board's next meeting will be November 10th at 6:30 pm. The Board welcomes your input. A segment of each Board meeting is reserved for Steward comments, suggestions, or questions. A suggestion box is in the Narthex.

October ended with our Noah's Ark theme and party (instead of a Halloween party). The halls were buzzing with all kinds of adorable animals.


November brings us so much to read and talk about. Being thankful for our family, friends, our food, homes and especially God who has been so good to us.

The Northern Illinois District Convention was held in Carol Stream Sep. 24th. Mission Grants were selected for funding from 2022-2024. Our Mites go to fund these grants and we need your prayer support. The grants include:

- 1) Concordia Seminary (St Louis) for \$8,000
- 2) Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch for \$4,000
- 3) Spreading Life Gospel for \$9,000,
- 4) Lutheran Bible Translators for \$15,000
- 5) Walcamp renovations and additions for \$18,000
- 6) MOSTMinistries; short term ministry training for \$8,000
- 7) Trinity Lutheran Church of Tinley Park; media center for \$10,668

- 9) Voice of Care; funding 175 persons in respite care for families within the church LCMS for \$10,000.


