Dear Saints,

We continue our walk through Christian art by taking a look at Jan van Eyck's "Adoration of the Mystic Lamb," the center panel of his *Ghent Altarpiece* (1432).

This beautiful painting helps us answer the question: "Where do we find Good Friday and Easter today?"

On Easter we will sing, "At the Lamb's high feast we sing/ Praise to our victorious King,/ Who has washed us in the tide/ Flowing from His pierced side. Alleluia!" (LSB 633, v. 1)

It is the "high feast" of the Lamb that we see in the painting, a picture of heaven that John gives us in Revelation:

"After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" (7:9-10).

Saints fill the frame of the painting, and there in the middle stands the Lamb on His throne, surrounded by fourteen kneeling angels. The Lamb receives their praise and adoration, but while he is triumphant, he is also slain. Blood pours from his pierced side into a chalice.

This Lamb has taken away the sin of the world (John 1:29) through his death and resurrection, and the saints have washed their robes and made them white in His blood (Revelation 7:14). He has died but now he lives forever!

But there's even more here. This painting also shows us how we receive the gifts of Christ's passion--Good Friday and Easter—today in worship.

Take a look at the fountain at the bottom of the painting, a picture of the water of life. Revelation tells us this water comes out of the throne and of the Lamb (22:1). Notice how the fountain almost touches the altar. Notice also how a stream flows down out of the fountain into our real space (it's a bit difficult to see). Because this altarpiece would have been above an altar, this would give the appearance of the water of life flowing directly into the center of the altar.

In other words, Van Eyck teaches us that in the Lord's Supper we truly are "at the Lamb's high feast" and receive the water of life that flows from the pierced side of Jesus. (continued on page 2)



Or as the hymn says, "Praise we Him, whose love divine/ Gives His sacred blood for wine,/ Gives His Body for the feast--/ Christ the victim, Christ the priest./ Alleluia!" (LSB 633, v. 2)

So where do we find Good Friday and Easter today? We find them in His Word, Baptism, and especially His Body and Blood. In these gifts, we receive the fruits of His victorious cross and resurrection.

BOARD OF MINISTRY DIRECTORS by Ken Ladage, Chairman

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

May knowing Jesus bring you peace to bless each day, hope for each tomorrow, and joy in every season. In our Lenten journey towards Easter, let us remember the One who humbled Himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross (Philippians 2:8). Let us renew our faith and receive with open hearts the love of God who makes us brothers and sisters in Christ.

Easter is April 9th and Holy Week services are scheduled as follows: Maundy Thursday at 7:00 pm, Good Friday at 12:00 pm and 7:00 pm, Easter Sunday at 6:00 am, 8:00 am and 10:30 am, and an Easter egg hunt at 9:45 am. Lenten dinners and services have been very well attended.

Here is the latest information from Ed Dennis and the Church Security Committee. Trauma Kits have been received and are currently available for distribution. The TLC Staff and Jamie will be attending a Huntley Fire Protection District training session on CPR/AED/Stop the Bleed. Pastor has been in touch with the HFPD to arrange similar training for himself, Elders, Board members and other church staff based on available space in the sessions. Once the HFPD sessions are scheduled, the Committee will reach out to others in the congregation who are often in the building to get as many Trinity members as possible trained. The Committee will also explore the acquisition of another AED unit for our basement level. Appropriate signage will be placed indicating the locations for our fire extinguishers, trauma kits and AEDS.

Trinity's financial performance is strong. We continue to operate in the black. February ended \$2,100 in the black and year to date we are \$12,000 in the black.

Church attendance has increased year to year. We have also welcomed several guests to our services. Remember the most effective Evangelism just involves inviting a friend or a neighbor to join you at a service.

Sunday Bible Study, Sunday School, and the Thursday Bible Study are all doing well. Confirmation is moving along with eight students. Confirmation will be Sunday, April 30th.

The Budget Committee is completing the preparation of budgets for Trinity and the TLC Preschool. Several significant infrastructure projects were budgeted and completed this year. However, due to the needs of our aging facility repairs and replacements will continue 2023-2024. Thanks to the financial support of our members these issues will be addressed as needed. The schedule calls for the budgets to be presented to the Congregation for review beginning May 28th. A Voters Meeting is scheduled on June 11th for Congregational approval.

The Board will be meeting April 13th and your input is welcomed. A segment of each Board meeting, (second Thursday of the month at 5:00 pm) is reserved for Steward comments, suggestions, or questions. A suggestion box is located in the Narthex.






