Dear Saints,

This month, we'll reflect on Edward Riojas' *The Parable of the Buried Treasure* (2013).

Riojas based this piece on one of Jesus' lesser known parables from Matthew 13: "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field" (v. 44).

This parable seems fairly straightforward. The buried treasure represents the value of God's kingdom. The man symbolizes every Christian. We are to so value being a member of God's kingdom that we would give up everything to keep it.

But Riojas asks us to imagine a different way of looking at this parable.

Instead of reading the parable where you are the man and the kingdom/Jesus is the treasure, reverse it. Imagine that you are the treasure, and Jesus is the man. But he's not in just a normal field, but a cemetery strewn with stones. Jesus sells all that he has—even his own life—and buys the cemetery to claim his hidden treasure—you!

As Luther says in his Small Catechism (echoing 1 Peter 3:18): "Jesus Christ [...] purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death, that I may be His own" (explanation to the Second Article of the Creed).

Riojas reinforces this point by depicting the treasure as a coffin—for we use a "coffer" for our valuable objects and a "coffin" for our valued deceased family and friends. The coffin also teaches Paul's point that we were all born dead in our trespasses and sins (Ephesians 2:1), unable to come to God or His Son. We were in a box that we could not escape. There was nothing valuable within us.

But Jesus found us. He dug us up. Because he still treasured us when we were sinful and dead. He gave "all that he had"—dying and rising again for you. He spoke to you and made you His own in Holy Baptism. And now you belong to Him.


We are not the doers. Jesus does the work. We are not the finders, but the found.

Or to put it another way: Jesus is our greatest treasure because we are first His greatest treasures.

How would it change you if you woke up every day and remembered that reality? If you realized that, despite your sin and shame and brokenness, Jesus thinks you are his greatest treasure?

BOARD OF MINISTRY DIRECTORS by Ken Ladage, Chairman

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

May Jesus Christ be praised, He is risen, alleluia. May what we do, may what we say and may what we write lead to praise of Him who redeemed us, who brought the "Good News" of salvation to the entire world.

A Voters Meeting was held on June 11th at 9:15 am to approve the 2023-2024 budgets for Trinity and the TLC Preschool. Pastor Hatesohl and Louise Johnson reviewed the material for the congregation. Budgets were approved by a unanimous vote.

Budget highlights for Trinity and TLC Preschool are as follows:

- Anticipated income for 2023-2024 is \$381,791.00 with \$381,791.00 expenses
- New expenses for this budget year will include the purchase of security and safety items, legal and professional fees, and replacement laptops
- A significant increase was provided for anticipated utility expenses
- Where appropriate a 4% inflation increase was budgeted
- The Preschool is budgeting for 80 students with a proposed income of \$199,550.00 and expenses of \$199,550.00

Additional financial information:

- Trinity Members have been generous in their giving, and it is anticipated that Trinity will finish the current budget year \$27,000 in the black
- The Joyful Living account has \$580,000 on hand for our future building project
- The Facility Maintenance & Improvement Fund has a balance of \$120,000
- The Emergency Fund has \$128,000 on hand
- Total assets for Trinity, including restricted or dedicated funds, are over \$910,000
- Trinity has approximately \$790,000 in laddered CD's earning 5% interest
- At this time Trinity remains debt free

The Lord has blessed Trinity as our church attendance continues to increase. Year to date attendance is up 40%. In the past year we have received 12 new adult members through adult confirmation and profession of faith. As referenced above Trinity continues to operate in the black. The annual Senior Picnic is scheduled for August 9th. Plans are being reviewed for designing a new sign and landscaping for the front of the church.

The Board will be meeting July 13th, your input is welcomed. A segment of each Board meeting, (second Thursday of the month at 5:00pm) is reserved for Steward comments, suggestions, or questions. A suggestion is located in the Narthex.

More exciting details from the convention will follow in the next newsletter!










