Dear Saints,

Back in June, our Gospel reading was from Matthew 9, the story of Jesus calling Matthew to be one of his twelve disciples. "As Jesus passed on from there, he saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax booth, and he said to him, "Follow me." And he rose and followed him" (9:9-13).

It's these verses that served as the inspiration for Caravaggio's *The Calling of St Matthew* (1599-1600).

Matthew was a tax collector, a man who had sold out his family, friends, and country to cooperate with the Roman enemy and become rich. Still, Jesus calls him by grace with his powerful words: "Follow me!"

Caravaggio powerfully emphasizes this point by his use of light. Light streams from the window behind Jesus onto the men sitting in darkness at the table. Jesus' call to Matthew is the only reason Matthew follows. Jesus finds him. Jesus enlightens him. Jesus gives him the power to follow.

The same is true for us. It is Jesus' words to us—words spoken, read, in the waters and the bread/Body and wine/Blood—that shower us with his grace, forgive our sins, and give us the Spirit to follow him. Jesus' call transforms our lives.

That's actually indicated by the posture of Jesus' hand. Take a closer look at his hand. Does it look familiar to you? It is almost a mirrored image of Adam's hand in Michelangelo's *The Creation of Adam* at the Sistine Chapel. In that familiar painting, God touches Adam's outstretched finger and imparts the spark of life.

Michelangelo seems to be portraying Jesus as the second, perfect Adam. Where Adam failed and sinned, Jesus succeeded and remained obedient. He is the perfect human, the true image of the invisible God (Colossians 1:15). His touch—we could say his words rattling in our ears—is a recreation. It makes us who we were meant to be from the very beginning, truly alive, loving God and one another (1 Corinthians 15:22).

One last thing: there's some debate as to who is Matthew in this painting, but the best case is that he's the bearded man pointing at himself as if to say, "Me?!?" That's a familiar experience in the lives of Christians. We can say, "Who am I to follow Jesus? Why would he call me, of all people? I am an unworthy sinner."

And you're right—you're not worthy. But Jesus has still called you by grace into his family. That's how grace works; it calls the unworthy.

Pope Francis actually said as much in some recent comments on this painting. He wrote, "Here, this is me, a sinner on whom the Lord has turned his gaze. [...] I am a sinner, but I trust in the infinite mercy and patience of our Lord Jesus Christ."

When you see this painting, I hope you can see yourself in this painting, too. As a sinner, yes. But as a forgiven, beloved sinner, dependent on the infinite mercy of Jesus.

The 2023 LWML National Convention in Milwaukee has ended and the new mission goal of \$2,350,00 has been set, new officers have been elected and 31 mission grants have been selected with the goal of servicing them through prayers and Mite offerings for the next two years.



The first three projects are: 1) The Orphan Grain Train Servant Center - \$100,000, 2) Healing Space for at risk children at Dakota Boys and Girls Ranch - \$100,000, 3) Serving Gods Children with Special Needs (Journeys Lutheran School) in Milwaukee, WI - \$100,000. Other projects will be given later in other articles.

Dear saints of Trinity,

I have received a call to serve as associate pastor at St. John Lutheran Church in Wheaton, IL. Let me explain what this means.

The call to be a pastor is a divine call. This does not mean that the pastor is divine—all evidence points to the contrary!—but that the pastor fills an Office instituted by Jesus himself, the Office of the Holy Ministry. Congregations call pastors to fill that office and deliver Jesus' Word and Sacraments faithfully.

When a call arrives, a pastor seeks to discover where he can do the most good for the Kingdom of God—where his gifts might be best used, his words best heard, and his skills best applied.

After prayer, visits, meetings with leaders, honest talk, advice from other pastors, and critical self-evaluation, the pastor can choose to decline the new call and continue to serve at his current church or accept the call and leave to serve at his new church.

What does this mean for us together at Trinity?

I currently have two divine calls: one to Trinity and one to St. John.

In the coming weeks, I will be deliberating between the two calls. My plan is to announce my decision on August 6. In the meantime, I welcome any input or questions you may have.

Most of all, please remember me and my family in your prayers, as we always include you in ours. We love you all.
