





Last month we listed three of the mission projects selected by our ladies at our convention in Milwaukee. We are trying to raise a total of \$2,350,000 over the next two years for the projects.

The next three grants are: 4) Lutheran Braille Workers (fortifying those that are visually impaired) - \$100,000, 5) Desert Response Team of Tyler, Texas - \$50,000, 6) Mobile Fire Kitchen (Forged by Fire Services), Gulf Coast Region - \$85,000.

We remember the widows mite story told in Mark 12:42-44 by Jesus of the woman who gave her small offering and pleased God. Her small coins were called Mites. We hope to use our small offerings to fund our grant projects. There are small boxes in the Narthex to hold donated coins. 




#### SUNDAY FELLOWSHIP HOUR FOR 2023
