Dear Saints,

Rarely in life, do we do anything at the bare minimum--at least things that really matter.

Raising our children, an important project at work, our wedding day-whatever important thing it is, we never settle for the bare minimum. We never do it halfway.

In John 10:10, Jesus says, "I came that they may have life, and may have it abundantly."

In other words, Jesus has come to bring you life--eternal life--but also real, abundant life right now. His life, given to us from baptismal font, lectern, pulpit, and altar--a life that never ends.

But how often do we, in church, settle for something halfway? How often do we do the bare minimum?

My encouragement for you this coming fall is to not settle for the bare minimum.

Come to church--even every week!--where Jesus gives you all his gifts.

But Jesus wants to give you even more. So take advantage of the various study opportunities we have at Trinity:

Sunday School (through 5th grade) is at 9:15 am. We'll meet in the sanctuary for a children's message and music, before heading downstairs for a Bible story. Learning the Bible stories well is a foundational part of learning the faith as a child.

Sunday Bible Study (6th grade through adulthood) is continuing its way through the Gospel of Matthew. We meet underneath the balcony at around 9:15 am.

Thursday Bible Study (adults) meets on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month. Join the study underneath the balcony for a brown bag lunch at 11:45 am. The study begins at 12:30 pm.

Catechumenate (adults) began September 23 at 8:45 am (it's not too late to join!). Join us for a breakfast of bagels, fruit, and coffee, followed by a conversation about our faith. This isn't just for those wishing to be members--it's for everyone, young and old, newer Christians and lifelong Christians.

Whatever it is, my encouragement is to not settle for less. Jesus has come to bring you all that is his. Don't miss out on all the gifts he has to give you.

BOARD OF MINISTRY DIRECTORS by Ken Ladage, Chairman

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

During September our ministry at Trinity transitioned from summer to fall. Pastor Krause' Bible Study resumed, Sunday Bible Study, Sunday School, Confirmation and New Member Classes also returned to the schedule.

Trinity's worship attendance continues to increase; March through August, year to date, is up 27%. The Senior Picnic in August had 60 Trinity Members and the Church Picnic in September was well attended. A "shout out" goes to Fellowship and the Elders for the success of these events.

The Strategic Planning Committee has completed its assignment to determine the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats that face Trinity. With that information, strategic outcomes with measurable goals were developed. A Townhall Meeting is scheduled for October 1st at 9:15 am to review the strategic outcomes and discuss their effect on Trinity's Ministry, future building plans and preschool.

There will be two Board of Ministry Directors positions up for election in early December. A Nomination Committee will be appointed to develop a slate of candidates. Church members may nominate individuals for the Board by submitting a form. However, before nominating an individual you need to receive their approval.

The Board has a different time beginning with our October September 12th meeting. The Board will meet at 6:00 pm and the Elders will meet at 7:15 pm. This schedule will reduce evening meeting commitments for Pastor.

The Board's next meeting will be October 12th at 6:00 pm. The Board welcomes your input. A segment of each Board meeting is reserved for Steward comments, suggestions, or questions. A suggestion box is in the Narthex.
