



BOARD OF MINISTRY DIRECTORS by Ken Ladage, Chairman

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

The work of the Church continues. The Church Security Committee continues to move forward with their plans. A second AED unit will be purchased for the basement level. These units are designed to be portable and could be placed wherever a potential use is needed

Trinity's financial position continues to be strong. The budget is currently operating in the black and we anticipate this continuing through the end of the current budget year.

The Village Team has received several building options developed by our Architect for the remodeling project. These options will be evaluated during their April Committee meeting and then presented to the Board for their review and input. With the plans in place the cost of the project can be determined and how the building expense will be handled by the Congregation. When the plan is complete the Congregation will review and potentially approve the final plans.

The Budget Committee has completed the budgets for Trinity and the TLC Preschool, and these will be sent to the Board of Ministry Directors for their review. The needs of our aging facility will continue to require repairs and replacements in 2024-2025. The budgets will be offered to the Congregation for review beginning in mid-May. A Voters Meeting will be scheduled on June 9th for Congregational approval.

The Board will be meeting May 9^{th,} and your input is welcomed. A segment of each Board meeting, (second Thursday of the month at 6:00pm) is reserved for Steward comments, suggestions, or questions. A suggestion box is located in the Narthex.
