Chairman John Drafall called the meeting to order at 11:45am. | Released: Pastor Hoffman opened with prayer.

Jan. 24, 2016, voters meeting minutes passed out for review as they weren't in the newsletter. Ceil Rieker commented that Joan Olsen's death was not listed. Pastor Hoffman apologized and said that it would be recorded. Rick Payne made a motion to accept the 1/24/16 meeting minutes; Jim Bollinger seconded. The motion passed.

Accepting new voting member, Ernie Link. (He signed the official book.) A motion made by Lyle Johannsen, and seconded by Betty Zirk to accept Ernie Link. Motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was presented. Bob Gillig wanted to know why TLC budget isn't provided with church budget; we need to know if they are running in the black or red, especially with upcoming vote for expansion. John Drafall asked Vicky Pillar, preschool director, to comment. She said TLC is currently in the red. She said the preschool is a mission and the expansion isn't only to provide for the preschool, it is designed for multi-purpose use. She understands that in the past TLC financial report was provided and it stopped at some point. She will make it available in the future. John Drafall commented that the preschool has always kept track of their own finances. Vicky said the main reason they are in the red is due to her salary.

Pastor's Report

Duties performed since 1/24/16 - seven Bible studies, eight confirmation classes, seven hospital visits, 18 home visits, 34 worship services, 29 meetings, 22 chapel sessions, two funerals (Bruce Weber is not listed since he was not technically/officially a member but attended regularly, two Baptisms (one for a TLC family).

During the summer months, he would like to hold various sessions to discuss concerns of the church. Sunday school continues to be an area that needs more volunteering; teachers are stretched thin. He also addressed our welcoming of visitors. Kathy Yerke wanted to thank Pastor for having the altar moved so his back is not always to the congregation.

Board of Stewardship - reported by Betty Zirk Lou Ann Jensen not present. Betty said they're not really doing anything right now but as we get closer to expansion meeting and beyond, they'll be busy.

Board of Trustees - Jerry Nepermann reported

- The outside spring cleaning is done.
- Watch for sign-up for indoor spring clean-up.
- The wind has blown off many shingles. They had some extras in the basement and repaired what they could.
 They had the steeper parts hired out. TLC wing needs roof repairs.
- Panels on the front of the church were also blown down.
 The company that installed them is out of business. If he can't find someone to make the repair, we'll have to rent scaffolding and repair ourselves.

TLC Preschool - report by Vicky Pillar

- Currently have 83 enrolled for next school year. We have 115 this year so they're getting close. More to come this summer and hoping the special events and activities will attract more. Best advertising is our own members with word of mouth. We're a licensed program and many preschools in our community are not.
- 4/23/16 from 9-10:30am is Child Safety Day. The sheriff's department will do car seat checks and discuss bike safety. They will have the classrooms open and provide snacks.
- 3) May 22 at the 10:30 service, will have a Baccalaureate Service for blessing of TLC graduates and have a picnic afterwards.
- 4) TLC made cards for US Naval sailors.
- Complimented Krissy Fossmeyer for the wonderful job she is doing with Facebook and PR. Very time consuming to do what she does.
- 6) VBS will have a little different set-up with groups of families; multi-aged children in each group. Reiterated the need for volunteers, even men. 90% of VBS attendees are non-members. It's a great way to send a family message.

Old Business - John Drafall and Pastor Hoffman

The Expansion Special Voters Meeting will be April 17,

- 2016. Everyone will be receiving additional information as it has been asked what the cost would be for renovation versus expansion.
- 2) A special Prayer Service with dinner will be on April 13 at 6:30pm. Lyle Johannsen asked how vote will be taken; John responded that it would be a closed written ballot. Ron Panning asked about the plans since they have just returned from winter travel. Pastor advised they are posted in the back and also in the basement.
- 3) Oktoberfest Pastor joked that it should be renamed Augtoberfest. They have the footprint of the layout, main tent to be in grass area behind the house that we own. The exit drive will be closed to car traffic. The Congregational Church will allow us to utilize their space for parking for \$1,000 per day. We declined; we will use our own lot and use the grass space we own.

<u>New Business</u> – John Drafall Nothing on the agenda.

Bruce Reinhold voiced his concern on the number of families we lose. We develop them and then they transfer. We need to pray to see what we can do to keep them. Do we consider another youth pastor? Pastor Hoffman said that this is exactly what he has asked the elders to do; talk to their members and find out what they need. We have 639 members. Why aren't they attending? We need to be more attuned to their needs. Elders should contact those members that transfer out to see why.

Ron Panning said he would like to make a motion that TLC financial report should be provided at meetings. John Drafall said he cannot accept the motion at this time. Ken Ladage commented that the motion is out of order and is not constitutionally correct. There are other means to provide that information. John left the motion on the floor and said we're not prepared to bring it to a vote. It will be brought back at a later date. Ken Ladage asked how long before the committee to revise the constitution and by-laws will be available. Pastor responded by the end of 2016.

The next voters meeting is scheduled for May 22, 2016, at 11:30am. A motion to close was made by Lyle Johannsen, seconded by Shelly Goers. Motion carried.

DID YOU KNOW...

The **chasuble** is the outermost liturgical vestment worn by clergy for the celebration of the Eucharist in Westerntradition Christian Churches that use full vestments, primarily in the Roman Catholic, Anglican, and Lutheran church. More recently, the chasuble has been readopted for Communion services in both Germany and North America.

A processional cross is a crucifix or cross which is carried in Christian processions. They became detachable from their staffs, so that the earliest altar crosses were processional crosses placed on a stand at the end of the procession. The Cross represents the Lord's presence at the altar.

A NOTE FROM RETA STOHS

Six ladies of the Trinity LWML attended the Spring Rally Zone 6 on Saturday April 9th at St Johns Lutheran Church in Algonquin. The theme of the gathering was the LCC K-9 Comfort Dog Ministry

featuring Butter and Comfort dogs Hannah and Wave.

Ladies attending from Trinity included Elaine Tanney, Grace Danielson, Gladys Stewart, Dee Mundt, Marlene Luedke and Reta Stohs. All attendees were shown that the comfort dogs are ambassadors for Christ and minister in places that church people cannot go. The dogs, which number about 123 now in service, are golden retrievers who are very sociable and have a calming influence with children and those facing traumatic situations. Butter is a dedicated dog to St Johns since January 2010 and visits nursing homes, schools, hospitals and shut-ins.

We also collect donations for food and household supplies for the Food Pantry all month. There is a basket in the Narthex to drop off items.






