There will be many and we have an important month ahead of us already. Voters Meeting Minutes—Trinity Lutheran Church, Huntley, IL

Chairman John Drafall called the meeting to order Sunday, November 27, 2016 at 11:50 am. Pastor Hoffman opened the meeting with prayer.

The minutes from the previous voters meeting, September 25, 2016, were presented. A motion was made by Rick Payne to approve the previous minutes; seconded by Ken Ladage. Motion approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> was presented. A motion to approve the report was made by Jim Bollinger; seconded by Phil Post. Motion approved.

Pastor's report

The By-Laws Committee should finish the new By-Laws and Constitution updates and submit it to the Northern Illinois District by the end of December. The new Constitution and By-Laws will present a new type of governance. An informational meeting to discuss the new type of governance will take place January 15, 2017.

Elder, Gary Schultze, reported:

Gary reported that an additional continuing education expense was not in the 2017 budget. The expense is for Doxology seminars. There are three seminars; one for Pastor, one for Pastor and a lay person, and one for Pastor and his wife, with the costs spread over 2016-2017. Cost would be \$1,600. Nancy Dvorak made a motion to have \$800 come out of the 2016 budget and \$800 out of the 2017 budget; seconded by Rick Payne. Motion carried. Kathy Yerke made a motion to accept the Elders report, seconded by Norm Fossmeyer. Motion approved.

Christian Education/Young Peoples Work

Missy Erath asked for prayers for the program. The children's Christmas program is December 17. The Very Merry Huntley event is December 3.

Missions/Evangelism

Marilee Payne reported that Trinity had a table at the October Del Webb Consumer Showcase. The missions/evangelism group adopted five families from the Grafton Food Pantry. Gifts requests are on the tree in the narthex. They have used Thrivent Dollars and left over were used toward LCC Comfort dogs, the Dakota Boys Ranch, Faith Lutheran Scholarship Fund, and the TLC Scholarship Fund.

Public Relations

Krissy Fossmeyer reported that she is working on posters for upcoming events. Members will be serving hot chocolate at the Very Merry Huntley event on December 3.

Trustees

Jerry Nepermann reported that the church has been winterized and he is in the process of getting rid of items in the rental property.

TLC Preschool

Vicky Piller reported that there are 109 children attending.

Old Business

Expansion Update by Pastor Hoffman:

Pastor was interviewed by Lutheran Church Extension Fund. The McHenry County Sheriff's Department will hold a one day training at the rental house. The Huntley Fire Department will use the property for four days of training. After all the trainings are complete, the house will come down.

The Clarity event was held in October. A committee is being formed to help with the process. The surveys were positive; one of the best things Trinity has going is TLC Preschool.

New Business

The proposed 2017 Budget was presented. There was discussion about the Preschool Director salary. The church is sharing the expense. The position involves working with church members on Trinity's children's ministries as well as community events. The new budget reflects the church's commitment to funding this position.

Oktoberfest was discussed. Should we keep holding the event if we are not making a profit? Is \$5,000 in 2017 enough? A motion was made by Bruce Reinhold to amend the 2017 budget for Oktoberfest from \$5,000 to \$15,000. Ken Ladage seconded the motion. There was more discussion about the actual expenses for the event. The motion passed 21-4 by a show of hands.

A motion was made by Muriel Fink to approve the 2017 budget; seconded by Chris Furmanek. Motion passed.

The next voters meeting will be January 29, 2017, after the 10:30 am service.

John Drafall adjourned the meeting and Pastor closed the meeting with prayer at 1:15 pm.

VOTERS MEETING



TLC PRESCHOOL NEWS

Ahhhh, it's January.

Time to kick back and relax...but not at TLC Preschool! We are beginning the registration process for the 2017-2018 school year, gearing up for another fundraiser (you're going to like this one; it won't cost you anything!), playing in the snow, learning new school skills as well as learning more about our friend Jesus. And, we'll also be celebrating Lutheran Schools Week.

Thank you to Trinity's members for the Christmas ornament that you gave to each TLC student. For many Christmases to come, this gift will be a reminder of their time at TLC as well as helping them remember that Christmas is all about that very first gift, our Savior, Jesus.

BIG NEWS! The State of Illinois has recently awarded TLC Preschool provisional Bronze status. This is the first step of the State's quality improvement program for Early Childhood Centers and is a voluntary program. Some of our teachers are currently applying for the State early childhood education teacher credentials. I have earned the director's credential and am already working on my next credential level. This is the beginning of our work as we look toward earning accreditation for TLC Preschool. This process requires a great commitment of time and energy as we participate in many hours of personal professional development as well as carefully evaluating our school and

what we can do to create an exemplary learning center that also fosters children's faith development. We are excited that the Bronze status comes with training stipends as well as some financial assistance to continue to purchase quality learning materials for our classrooms.
