VBS BY THE NUMBERS

1. TLC hosted its annual Vacation Bible School July 16-19 from 5:30–8:00 p.m. This year's theme was "Miraculous Mission" which focused on God's creation, His saving acts, and the most miraculous mission of sending His Son, Jesus, for our salvation. The space-based theme blended wonderfully with the attention being given that week to the 50th anniversary of the Apollo 11 Mission.
2. TLC reached out to members of our congregation and our community through God's word and the study of His miraculous creations, enrolling 61 children ages Pre-K to 5th grade in our week's activities/lessons.
3. TLC served approximately 400 meals to these children, their siblings, and parents over the course of the four nights of VBS.
4. TLC was blessed to have more than 50 members of our congregation (and also a few friends who are not members) volunteer their time and talents to make our week of VBS a success! A BIG thanks to those who responded to the call for help for the Friday closing session, as we had many volunteers who were unable to be there due to schedule conflicts.
5. TLC collected \$248 for our VBS Mission, Baby Bottle Boomerang, on behalf of Lutheran Family & Children Services of Missouri.
