
WOMEN'S CONNECTION

ROOM AT THE INN WINTER SHELTER

The Board of Social Ministry is assisting with the mission of Room at the Inn Winter Shelter, and we could use your help.

Room at the Inn (RATI) provides a safe and warm environment for individuals from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. during the winter months without judgment. This shelter is the only “wet” shelter in Boone County, offering services even to those under the influence.

RATI is a mission within several faith-based organizations in Columbia, and they are currently in need of our support. They assist those who have nothing to give in return, and they assure that Columbia's homeless individuals will not freeze in extreme winter weather conditions.

RATI runs this winter season from December 8, 2019 through March 15, 2020.

They need assistance with:

- Shelter shifts (evening, night, and morning)
- Set up at locations (RATI moves to different churches weekly)
- Laundry delivery
- Morning host with breakfast and clean up
- Donations of socks, gloves, hats, warm coats, boots, insulated underwear, etc.
- Financial donations

If you would like to provide a financial donation, you can place a gift into a “designated gift” offering envelope and note it is for Room At The Inn Winter Shelter. Donations are needed now as well as throughout the year. They will set up again in late 2020 for the next winter season. 
