For May 23, 2021 - The Day of Pentecost

Ezekiel 37:1-14

1. Where are the Israelites living when the Lord speaks these verses to them? Ezekiel 36:8 gives a strong hint. The year is after 586 BC, the siege and fall of Jerusalem, meaning the people are in ___ ___ i ___ e in B ___ b ___ ___ ___ n. Why are they living there?
2. A person's belief in God walks a road between two extremes: overconfidence and despair. What was the condition of the Ezekiel's hearers after hearing his preaching, in v. 37:11?
3. What does God do for the bones that he does in Genesis 2:7?

Acts 2:1-21

4. Pentecost was a regular festival of the Jewish calendar. Read Leviticus 23:15-21. How many days after the Passover Sabbath is the festival? The name we use "Pentecost" comes from the Greek word for the number ___ ___ .
5. What are the "last days" the prophet Joel through St. Peter speaks of in v. 17? See Hebrews 1:2, 1 Peter 1:19, 20.

John 15:26-27; 16:4b-15

6. In verses 10-11, Jesus says the world is not righteous. Read John 12:34-50. What is the sin Jesus is speaking to in vv. 34-50?

Accordingly, what will the work of the Holy Spirit be, when He is breathed out by God on a person? Read Ephesians 1:17-20.
