

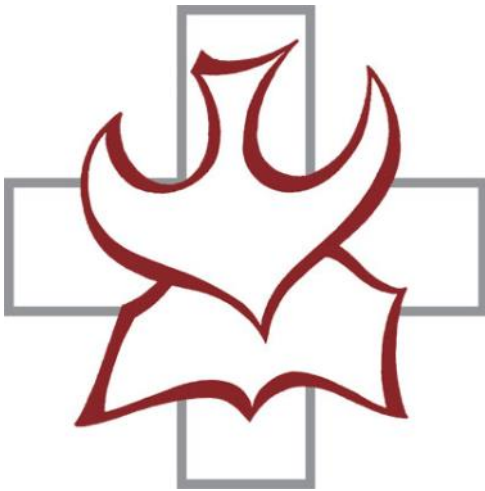

### Even *This* is the Day

The kids here, especially at Iglesia Luterana Confesional de Pueblo Nuevo, *love* to belt out "This is the Day." Maybe the title alone had you humming the tune, too. It's a catchy ditty that, like so many, springs straight from the pages of Scripture—Psalm 118:24, in this case:

*This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.*

If it sounds familiar for reasons unrelated to children's ministry, it may be because vv. 15-29 are the appointed Psalm for Easter Sunday in the 1-year lectionary. Obviously the Lord was behind the events of *that* day, and the rejoicing and gladness are palpable. But what about all the non-Easter days?

The Psalmist speaks of being in distress (v. 5), of being surrounded by enemies he likens to bees and fire (v. 12), and of being disciplined severely (v. 18). I can think of a *few* things that cause distress (hurricanes and cancelled flights, cough cough). Discouragement and loneliness sting and burn. And as children of the Heavenly Father, we endure His chastisement oh so acutely. Indeed, some days, I can relate. Did the Lord make those days, too? Does He expect me to rejoice? Surely, the "this" doesn't refer to Good Friday, as Christ hung on the cross in utter anguish after having been spit on and jeered by an angry mob, moments away from succumbing to the ancient world's cruelest form of punishment?

These are the days that the Lord has made. Yesterday. Today. Tomorrow. The distressing days. The days when we see no way out. The days when tough love is...tough. Good Friday. The Creator of time itself heard the Psalmist's cries, swept in to deliver him, and relinquished His rod. And for His crowning act, "the stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone" (v. 22).

Without Good Friday, there's no Easter Sunday. And it's because of Easter Sunday that we can say as long as the Lord promises that His steadfast love will endure—forever (v. 29)—that no matter what befalls us, this, even this, is the day He has made.

Beyond nomenclature, said status
