Epistle

1 Corinthians 6:12–20

¹²“All things are lawful for me,” but not all things are helpful. “All things are lawful for me,” but I will not be enslaved by anything. ¹³“Food is meant for the stomach and the stomach for food”—and God will destroy both one and the other. The body is not meant for sexual immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body. ¹⁴And God raised the Lord and will also raise us up by his power. ¹⁵Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? Never! ¹⁶Or do you not know that he who is joined to a prostitute becomes one body with her? Distribution & Distribution Hymns:

The pastor and those who assist him receive the body and blood of Christ first and then distribute them to those who come to receive. Only individual cups will be offered at this time. Purple cups are non-alcoholic.

Family groups will be ushered to the communion rail and remain standing while communing (don't touch the rail or cushion). Masks will be worn as you approach and exit the rail and as the Elder and Pastor are distributing the elements. After you are given the elements, you will hold onto the bread and the wine until everyone has been served. Then you can lower your mask and Pastor will announce, "take and eat/drink." You may partake of the Lord's Supper at this time. After you have finished you will put your masks back on and exit back to your seats, placing the communion cup into the basket on either side of the Sanctuary.

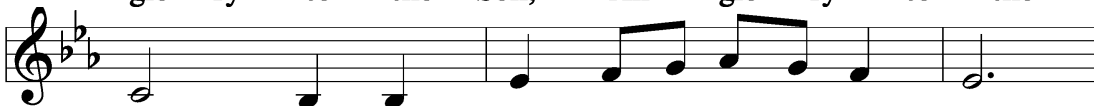


