"...Lord. when was it that we aw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink ...."

Excerpt from Matthew 35:341-45

The quoted excerpt comes from one of Jesus' more famous exhortations to his disciples. In this passage, he declares that on the day of judgment, the Sheep and the Goats will be separated based on their acts towards a variety of people, including those who are hungry and thirty. Jesus connects the act of helping the hungry and thirsty, among other charitable acts, as being done to him. Though, neither the sheep nor the goats realized that it was Jesus they were either helping or (in the case of the goats) not helping.

It was not the Goats fault that they did not recognize Jesus in those they walked by. It is not that the Sheep were wiser that they did help, not knowing they were actually serving Jesus. It just happens. How do we get lost sometimes in our own ways and not recognize Jesus in the needy around us? Perhaps because we get really wrapped up in ourselves. And when we get wrapped up in ourselves, we tend to not be looking for Jesus. How can we get out of our own way and begin to intentionally look for Jesus?

For starters, this Lent, I invite you to fast from self-centeredness and to let that fast open you to where Jesus is found in the hungry and thirsty of the world. The children's sermons, our meals at our Wednesday Lunch and Devotions, our Wednesday night Bible Study, our March EPIC Sunday School, and our March Mission Focus all are themed around the crisis of World Hunger. This theme was chosen to help us fast from selfcenteredness and be more open to others.

These many ways we will engage the theme during Lent will help us learn about the causes of hunger and point us to the hope within the crisis. It is my hope we will even realize just how we can work together with our state and national legislators to work for policies to change the causes of hunger.

Martin Luther wrote, in his commentary on Psalm 82, "For so to help a man that he does not need to become a beggar is just as much of a good work and a virtue as to give alms to a man who has already become a beggar."

Whether we fight for justice and equality for those suffering extreme poverty and hunger in third world countries, or whether we champion the cause for better sustainable wages in our own backyard, we follow the call of Jesus when we see those who are hungry or thirsty, and we provide for them, as if we are providing for our very Lord and Savior, whose death and resurrection bring us new life and the courage to serve.
