

You set the boundaries of the earth, and you made both summer and winter.

Psalm 74:17

Did you know the word "Summer" appears in the Bible 26 times? I was actually surprised to find it, I had not thought much of it whether it was or not in the Bible, but a quick search on Biblegateway.com gave me the answer. Here is one of the more fascinating finds in this search:

Honor is no more associated with fools than snow with summer or rain with harvest.—Proverbs 26:1

Or this verse: Day and night your hand of discipline was heavy on me. My strength evaporated like water in the summer heat. — Psalm 32:4

It is the summertime and for many of us that means weekend boating, camping, or getaways with family and friends. For our children it means a break from school and the daily grind of bus rides, homework and sports practices. Summer introduces new routines of summer jobs, gardening, golfing or fishing or both. Here God's Word does not take a break from comforting our souls, revitalizing our faith, and strengthening us for our journey.
