Habakkuk 2:4

500 years ago on the eve of All Hallows Day, a feisty German monk, priest, and professor changed the world. Martin Luther was that feisty German monk, priest, and professor. And the legend of his nailing 95 Theses for debate on the church door in Wittenberg sparked the Reformation.

What does the Reformation mean? Well, for starts it means Martin Luther questioned the hows and whys of the Church, at that point, the only Church. He realized the church had become stagnant and oppressive and corrupt and content with keeping the world's status quo. He realized the Gospel message was quite contrary to this, the Gospel was life-bearing, changing, transformative, and most importantly, it set people free.



Reformation Day

The Gospel sets people free from oppression, free from the status quo, free from belaboring the point that we are sinners who must suffer as a consequence. The Gospel sets us free to be agents of change, to bring life, to be transformative and to set others free around us.

The Reformation may not feel quite as impactful today, after all 500 years later there is no one single Church, there are now hundreds of Christian denominations freely expressing their own beliefs. The Reformation may not speak quite so boldly as we have become settled into a new status quo, one that Martin Luther could never have imagined.

And yet, this era of history is not simply in the past. The Reformation has not ended. It is actually quite active and still happening in the world around us today. The Reformation needs to impact our stagnant lives, the Reformation needs to bear life to and through us, the Reformation needs to open our eyes to the transformative power of the Gospel.

As we celebrate 500 years of legend and Gospel revival, let us pray that the Holy Spirit would enrapture us into the continuing Reformation, that new life may awaken us and stir us from placidness and be the wind that pushes us forward bringing good news to the world.

Week of October 1 to October 7

Pray that people who feel compelled to riot may find their peace and that all neighborhoods may welcome diversity and walk hand in hand.
