Thanksgiving Day is around the corner. It is the holiday squished between the over-marketed Halloween and over-marketed Christmas. But do not worry, Thanksgiving gets it proper due. Families gather and feast on a myriad of traditional dishes. The NFL does not let the day go by without a game or three. And the Macy's parade in New York City captures the hearts of every kid watching the bands march and the big balloon characters float on by.

Each Thanksgiving we take a moment to ponder what we are grateful for during the past year. It is the obligatory conversation before we slice up Tom Turkey and cry foul over all the missed penalties. And we pat our kids and ourselves on the back for taking the one time of the year to be thankful and to express that thankfulness.

But what if I told you that saying thanks is not a once-a-year, make-yourself-feel-good exercise. Being thankful is something we actually do every Sunday in worship. When we give our offering, we follow up with a prayer that expresses our Thanks to God for what God has done for us. The language varies depending on what order of service we are following, but the expression is the same.

"With these gives, we bless you," "with these gifts we offer ourselves" "these gifts ... offered in great thanks-giving": these are just some of the ways we take a moment each Sunday to say Thank You to God. After all, everything that we have is a gift from God to begin with. The very breath we breathe, the school we attend, the work we do, the home we live in, the food we eat. It is all gift. Every day is a gift. Saying Thank You to God is not a once-a-year, obligatory moment between feasting and football. Saying Thank You is a powerful act of our faith.

As you come to this moment in worship on Sunday morning, the moment the offering plate is passed around, perhaps you fallen victim to the all too common, "I guess it is time to pay my dues to church" or "I guess we have to pay the bills at church" feelings. How much more impactful is it when that plate comes around and you stop and realize that this is your weekly Thanksgiving. It is not couched in feasts or sports. It is our joyful response each week—saying Thank You for all that God has done in our lives.

So this Thanksgiving, let your conversation not be about once-a-year thanks; let your conversation be about how every week, in fact every day, can say Thank You to our creator and savior.




