# Glad Tidings "Sound the Good News"



And the LORD God planted a garden in Eden, in the east; and there he put the man whom he had formed. Out of the ground the LORD God made to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight and good for food, the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Genesis 2:8-9



The old expression "April showers bring May flowers" is in full bloom now as we turn the calendar page to May. It seemed like spring had sprung a winter leak, but all is repaired and the weather is back on track and our flowers are blooming and our vegetables are planted and our farmer's markets are opening with fresh local produce. We all have different favorite flowers, and all our gardens are unique and beautiful as they come back to life this time of year.

Take a moment and admire your garden, your work. What flowers have already bloomed? What flowers are budding? What flowers have you planted that will come to life later in the season? Doesn't it just give you great joy just watching it and anticipating all the life that is to come in your garden?

In the second creation story of Genesis, we are told God planted a garden. There God prepared a home for the first man and then the first woman. And God probably was feeling much like you are as you look out on your garden and take delight in the colorful blooms and the sweet scent of each flower. And God probably had great anticipation for how his creation would come to life as the season progressed.

Now many of us tend to read the creation story as a past-tense event. God created. God rested and his creative work was completed. But this is not so. God is not done with creation. In fact, creation happens around us continually. These earliest stories of our Bible are not past-tense, but are on-going stories that we are very much a part of today.

In fact, God placed his first man and first woman in the garden to be partners with God in the continuing work of creation. And that partnership continues today with you and me. We are God's partners in the continuing work of creation. From planting our own personal gardens, to crafting a house into a home, to caring for the environment beyond just our own 40 acres; we are God's partners in an on-going and very much always continuing work of creation.

So admire your small corner for a moment, the joy of your chores as your flowers come up. Then take a wider view of all creation—and just think what it can be as we work in partnership with God in bringing to life the creation God has begun and continues through us.

A letter from Rev. Kurt Nordby, the NIS Assistant to the Bishop for Stewardship and Development

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you to the close of the age."

Matthew 28:19-20

These words of Jesus remind us of the ministry imperative we have together as a church and how all of us are called to participate in God's mission of proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ. Our Northern Illinois Synod takes seriously the Great Commission of Jesus to go and proclaim the gospel.

For the past number of years, we have been blessed with the Northern Illinois Synod Mission Fund. The Synod Mission Fund enables us to boldly proclaim the gospel by providing ministry grants in partnership with the ELCA for starting new missions, redeveloping congregations, and providing seed money for specific outreach ministries in congregations.

Our NIS is blessed by a number of new ministries such as Freedom Lutheran Church in Oregon, Dwell in Yorkville, and Intersections in Genoa which was just recently approved by the NIS Council. Grants from our Synod Mission Fund will be vital in supporting these new ministries. Our Synod Mission Fund has been instrumental in the proclamation of the good news of Jesus through new ministries such as Freedom, Dwell, and Intersections.

Indeed our Synod Mission fund is a blessing! However, today the Synod Mission Fund has about a year and a half of life remaining. It is important that we strengthen the Synod mission Fund so that we can continue to be bold in proclaim the Gospel.

NIS "Gifts for Mission" Generosity Sunday is May 20, 2018! In order to strengthen our Synod Mission Fund, we will have a synod-wide Generosity Sunday on Pentecost Day, Sunday, May 20th. The goal of our "Gifts for Mission" program is \$200,000. "Gift for Mission" Generosity Sunday will be an exciting opportunity for congregations and individuals of the NIS to share a one-time gift for the purpose of building our Synod Mission Fund. It is also a meaningful way to participate in the joy of reaching out with the gospel in a way that one congregation cannot do alone.
