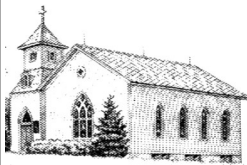

- 1) we are asking that we not congregate in the narthex, we encourage visiting outside in areas where you can distance and sit.
- 2) Please use the hand sanitizer in the narthex before you pick up your bulletins. Then proceed to your pew.
- 3) The pews are marked so that we will sit in every other pew, family members and persons who have been in physical contact during this time may, of course sit together. But in order to safe guard others no more than 5 persons per pew. Please sit in the ends of the pews, no one in the middle.
- 4) Pastor will not be greeting or shaking hands before or after church. If you need to communicate with her please call, text, or email, send her a note during service or, just address her during the start of our service.
- 5) We will not be sharing the peace.
- 6) Communion will be set up in front of the altar; families or individuals will come forward to commune.

The guidelines that have been set forth by our governing bodies apply to all meetings at church, that includes weddings and funerals.
