

Epiphany

- Epiphany is a Greek word that means appearance or manifestation.
- In the Christian East the feast of the Epiphany marked the beginning of the celebration of the birth of Christ.
- The Feast of Epiphany was later adopted by the Christian West. Where it is celebrated together with the Christmas season.
- Originally, Epiphany marked the end of the season of Christmas in the Churches of the West.
- Epiphany was celebrated twelve days after the beginning of Christmas.





Epiphany of our Lord. This year its on Wednesday, January 6th, 2021

The feast of Epiphany ("manifestation") concludes the Christmas season with a celebration of God's glory revealed in the person of Jesus Christ. In Isaiah and Ephesians, that glory is proclaimed for all nations and people. Like the light of the star that guided the magi to Jesus, the light of Christ reveals who we are: children of God who claimed and washed in the waters of baptism. We are sent out to be beacons of the light of Christ, sharing the good news of God's love for all people.


