



Dear members and friends of Faith on Forty,

We can live fully no matter what dire straits we are in. That's the message of Lent. Jesus, getting himself deeper and deeper into trouble, ends up being in a terrible situation during Holy Week. He is accused for speaking the truth of God's healing love and forgiveness. He does not cower in fear, nor run away; but brings God's message of forgiveness, love and mercy to the very last moment. That's resurrection here and now.

Living fully with less is the purpose of the practice of giving up something for Lent. If we give up something - we learn that we can live without it: we can live fully with less. Life can bring us up against serious moments of loss. Can we live as fully as possible in threatened moments of loss with Jesus as our model?

James Carroll in one of his books tells us a terrible story of the time that he discovered his faith was alive when facing a loss. It happened on an Eastern Airlines flight. At one point in the flight the pilot's voice came over the speaker "Emergency, mechanical failure, be calm, prepare." The passengers were told it was 20 minutes to impact. Carroll was terrified. He had 20 minutes in which to remember how to pray. He had 20 minutes to live. He had 20 minutes to die.

Through skill and miracle, the plane landed safely but what he said about those 20 minutes is this. "What matters to me about those 20 minutes is that I died, no matter what the newspaper says - I died. By the time that plane came to a stop on the runway, I had died. I was gone. But resurrection is what happens when we survive unexpectedly. If there is a promise in that day it is this: I who died, lived."

And that's the message of Lent = that every moment of life is a moment on the border of life and death. As St. Paul said, "whether we live or whether we die we belong to the Lord." We are all on that edge, and every moment we live is a resurrection moment; both here and in the hereafter.

Live fully no matter what. Live into the resurrection life every day. In Jesus Christ we live fully both here and hereafter - no matter the circumstances. This is the truth that will set us free. "You will know the truth and the truth will set you free." (John 8:32)
