Sun, June 5, 5:30 PM - 8:00 PM, FIRST BALLOT (on ZOOM)



ASH WEDSNDAY IF FAST APPROACHING.

If you've started to spot Peeps or other Easter-themed candy in your local convenience store's aisles, then it's fair to say that the Easter season will be here before you know it (even if it feels eons away at the moment). And if you're a practicing Christian, then this may mean planning when to attend church services for Easter, Palm Sunday, and Ash Wednesday this spring.

Traditionally, Christians observe the 40 days of Lent, which begins with Ash Wednesday. Like Easter, the exact timing of Ash Wednesday changes each year, but the traditions remain the same. Though not every person observes Ash Wednesday in the same way, the most traditional form of the day involves a church service, a mark of the cross, and an entry into the season of Lent. Ash Wednesday is the time when you may finally decide on what you want to give up for Lent, or perhaps it's an opportunity to spent a quiet moment on some Easter prayers.

Ash Wednesday is the day that marks the beginning of Lent, which is the 40 days leading up to Easter Sunday. These 40 days are meant to represent the 40 days that Jesus spent in the desert fending off the temptation of the Devil, according to the Bible. On Ash Wednesday, followers attend a church service where they will receive a cross of ashes on their forehead (made from the ashes of burnt palms from the previous year's Palm Sunday). For many Christian denominations, Ash Wednesday is a day of both fasting and repentance.

""Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. Do not quench the Spirit."

1 Thessalonians 4: 16-19

On Ash Wednesday our foreheads are marked with ashes and we hear the sobering words, "remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return." We will begin Lent a bit later than usual this year and remember that Easter also will be slow in coming.

For some, the Lenten season is gloomy and unpleasant and so they avoid it. Penitence, contrition, remorse, the themes of Lent, are unsettling. Who wouldn't rather skip the gloom and go straight for the glory?

But St. Paul reminds us in his first letter to the Thessalonians that the things of God—joy, prayer, giving thanks, can be known in all circumstances. Lent is but a preparation for the circumstances of our lives that are less than glorious. The Spirit, God's Holy Spirit, is with us, helping us, in whatever difficulty or joy or sorrow or pleasure we encounter, in whatever discipline we might choose to undertake. Prayer is the acknowledgment that God is present in all such circumstances of our lives.

For the season of Lent this year, we focus on the theme of Prayer. The theme of our mid-week worship services is "Famous Prayers and Famous Pray-ers." Ash Wednesday we will look at perhaps the most famous prayer of all—the prayer our Lord taught us—the Lord's Prayer.

In following weeks (see schedule below), we will look at some of the "giants" in our faith tradition—including Martin Luther, Mother Teresa, St. Francis of Assisi and others, who have prayed and written prayers prayed by countless faithful persons in countless circumstances. We will use Holden Evening Prayer in both locations: in the basement at First, Jordan and in the chapel at Trinity.
