



All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. —Acts 2: 4

The account of the Day of Pentecost in the book of Acts is a day of "keyhole theology" - when we look through the keyhole of history to catch a glimpse of God's ultimate purpose for a new humanity and a new creation. The Spirit baptizes the imagination to glimpse the future beyond our limited horizons.

For the disciples of Jesus, the Day of Pentecost looks back at and reverses the Tower of Babel story where God confused one language into many languages. At Pentecost, the disciples of Jesus are able to speak in many languages so that all can hear the Gospel and about 'God's deeds of power.'

Peter declares the words of the ancient prophet Joel have come to pass. Now, 'in these last days', the days after Jesus, the Holy Spirit will be poured out and all will have the opportunity to prophesy. The social impact of the Holy Spirit is dramatic - the "democratization of the Spirit" - no longer for only the special few such as kings, priests and prophets, but now for women and men, young and old, servant and master.

Pentecost challenges those who would like to think they are in control. "To prophesy," in the tradition of the Old Testament prophets, is to be able to see, feel and communicate to others by divine inspiration. Not personal will, but God's will, as revealed in the Holy Spirit. In the words of *Pentecost Hymn* by Ken Bible:

"Your promise is given in wind and in flame, With lives now ignited to burn in Your name. Now loving, now holy, now bold in the truth, Your body, Your people are one, Lord, in You.

We praise You, our Father, the Fountain of Life, For comfort and challenge, for purpose and light. In love we will share all the gifts You provide That all may be blessed and our Lord glorified.

Your challenge is sounding. Our calling is clear: To live out a gospel the needy can hear. Lord, help us to go till all people have heard And touch every life with the love of the Lord.
