



"I'm sure about this: the one who started a good work in you will stay with you to complete the job by the day of Christ Jesus." Philippians 1:6, CEB.

A few years ago in a movie called "Click," the comedian Adam Sandler played Michael Newman, a husband and father on the fast track to success. Then one day he was given a universal remote that gave him the power to fast forward through the hard parts of his life to get to the good parts of his life.

In the movie, Michael discovers that his use of the universal remote has also fast forwarded him through parts of his life he <u>wanted</u> to experience. Unfortunately, Michael also discovers that the journey of learning through all of the hard parts were the foundation of the life he longed for. In the end he learns that the easy road and the easy "click" were anything but good. The remote cheated him of his life.

The idea in the movie "Click," I'm afraid, is how many people approach their faith. They don't want to have to think too hard about it, give much attention to it, or sacrifice anything for it. We become accustomed to "instant," microwaveable everything, and so something that asks us for our whole lives [church] seems too much. Church is not something that "works" instantly.

Church is day in, day out, week in, week out, month after month, year after year, communion with God's people. It's push and shove, highs and lows, feast and famine. Church is not a building where you go, but it is the body of Christ and we members of it. Church isn't about "me" and what "I get out of it." Church is about "us" and *Who* makes us one (Jesus). Church is about ministering and ministry, not by one person or a few people, but by everybody. Church is about prayer and perseverance, about worship and resolve. Church is, like your life, a work in progress.
