



Apr 27th—O Divine One, help us always to work for understanding and fellowship with one another. In Jesus' name. Amen



"This is the reason why our theology is certain: because it seizes us from ourselves and places us outside ourselves." — Martin Luther

(Note: this is the Seventh in a series of seven on Martin Luther's "7 Marks of the Church")

It is fitting that I write about the Seventh (and last!) Mark of the Church—"The Sacred Cross," — as we approach Holy Week.

Christians are not recognized through acts of glory or by exaltation of themselves. Luther writes how the church is truly recognized, "by the holy possession of the sacred cross. [Christians] must endure every misfortune and persecution, all kinds of trials and evil from the devil, the world, and the flesh (as the Lord's Prayer indicates) by inward sadness, timidity, fear, outward poverty, contempt, illness, and weakness, in order to become like their head, Christ…"

Luther continues, "Wherever you see or hear this, you may know that the holy Christian church is there, as Christ says in Matthew 5 [:11–12], "Blessed are you when [others] revile you and utter all kinds of evil against you on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven." This too is a holy possession whereby the Holy Spirit not only sanctifies [God's] people, but also blesses them."

The way of Christ is suffering, not as a doormat, but by freely giving of oneself for others. The church is that body of people who pours itself out for the world. We do this knowing that, in Christ's death there is victory over death.

Martin Luther called this self-emptying done by the church *theologia crucis*, or "Theology of the Cross," that God works in ways that to the naked eye seem foolish (see I Corinthians 1:17-25). The church then, at its "best" looks like a gathering of sinners rejected by God and the world, whereas it is in truth the beloved people of God. The church cannot be judged by its appearance, but only by whether it has the Word of Christ crucified.

To summarize: these are Luther's 7 marks of the Church:

The Holy Word of God

The Sacrament of Holy Baptism

The Sacrament of the Altar (Communion)

The Office of the Keys Exercised Publicly (Confession & Absolution)

The Calling, Consecrating and Ordaining of Ministers

Prayer, Public Praise and Thanksgiving to God (Liturgy/Public Worship)

The Sacred Cross

In Christ, Crucified and Risen,
