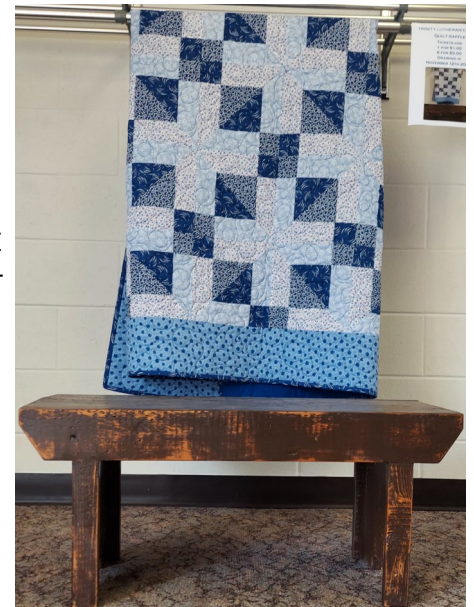

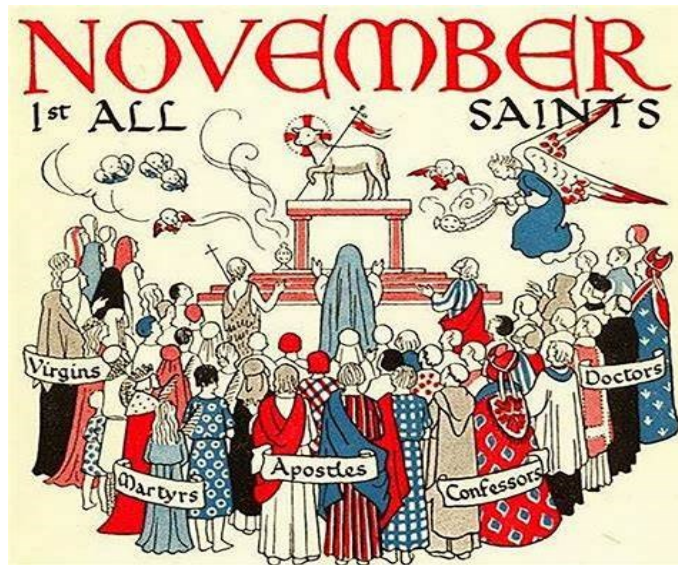

“But the souls of the righteous are in the hand of God, and no torment will ever touch them.

Wisdom of Solomon 3: 1

Traces of an observance for the saints who had died began in the early centuries of the church. Christians were accustomed to solemnize the anniversary of a martyr's death for Christ at the place of martyrdom. The word “martyr”—meaning “witness”—became associated with Christians whose witness often led to persecution or death.

In the persecution of Roman Emperor Diocletian (d. 305) the number of martyrs became so great that a separate day could not be assigned to each. But the Church, feeling that every martyr should be acclaimed, appointed a common day for all.

Pope Gregory IV (827-844) extended the celebration of All Saints to the entire Church and instituted its observance on November 1. The vigil of this feast became known as the “Eve of all Hallows” and is popularly called “Hallowe'en” or “Halloween.”

Although the popular culture separates these days (or even ignores All Saints altogether), we in the church continue to observe them. In Faith on 40 Parish, we remember particularly saints in our congregation who have died over the past year and also others, known and unknown. We give thanks for the lives of saints because they are our witnesses—our inspiration for living faithful lives.

We celebrate the lives of the saints not because of what they achieved in life, but because God claimed them in holy baptism, lead them through life and received them in death. We observe All Saints as a reminder that our time to be God’s people on earth is short and so that each day might be a celebration.

Hopefully by the time you read this you and yours celebrated Halloween or “All Hallows Eve” with a bit of festivity, preparing us for the more solemn celebration, but a celebration nonetheless (!), of All Saints.

For all the saints, who from their labors rest, who thee by faith before the world confessed, thy name, O Jesus, be forever blest. Alleluia, Alleluia!
