
January Mission Focus: Milledgeville school kids

Epiphany, a moment of sudden revelation or insight. Epiphany, a manifestation of the divine. Epiphany, an aha moment, when you say, "I get it. I know who you are." Epiphany, the Feast Day Christians celebrate on January 6th marking the day the Magi came and revealed the Christ child to the gentiles. These are the many definitions of the word Epiphany. Epiphany is also a season of the Church year. It is the season that bridges the gap between the stories of Christmas, Jesus' birth, and Lent and Holy Week, the stories of Jesus' betrayal and death.

The season of Epiphany is a season of discovery of who Jesus is. It begins with Jesus' baptism, and a voice from heaven saying, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased." The season ends at the transfiguration, when the voice from heaven once again declares, "This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!"

In between is a season of discovery highlighted by the question of John's disciples, —"Are you the one?" Yes, the very one who baptized Jesus still has questions about who Jesus is. The people of Nazareth wonder who is this who speaks with such authority. Demons seem to know who Jesus is, but those he encounters in his ministry—from beggars to Pharisees, from hometown neighbors, to fishermen called to leave their boats, all wonder who is this Jesus.

This season of Epiphany, we open the Gospel of Luke and we will follow it from Jesus' baptism to his Passion. Who will you discover as we open our hearts to these stories?

Will you discover a radical leader of a dissident group of people looking to overthrow Rome? Will you discover a faith healer, whose magic surpasses all doctors and other medicine men? Will you discover a rebel who openly mocks the religious authorities? Will you discover the Son of God, who frees and liberates you from the grip of sin and sets you onto a path of service and humility?

Who will you discover this Epiphany season? Jesus invites you to enter his Word and join in the discovery and to experience your own Epiphany this season.

We read a Bible story, usually have a related craft. We sing some of their favorite songs. We pray together.


They join us for worship a couple times each month. We have other special ways we get together. But this is a great relationship we have. Join us and be touched by this amazing ministry.

Mark your calendars now for Lent

Ash Wednesday is March 1st. Worship is at 7PM at Trinity.

Our Lenten Midweek Lunch and Devotion will begin Wednesday, March 8 at noon.

This year's theme will be the Easter Vigil readings. The Easter Vigil is typically held on Holy Saturday (between Good Friday and Easter) and it is a dramatic experience of lighting a new candle and hearing God's promise of salvation through 12 Old Testament readings, and then culminating with the pronouncement of Jesus' resurrection. In Lent, we will spread it out over the 5 weeks and experience it a little a time, but it will be just as powerful.



The Church Season after Epiphany and the Church Season after Pentecost are sometimes called "Ordinary Time".

In this instance, Ordinary does not refer to "unspecial, regular, or normal". It comes from the fact the weeks are numbered in a series, and the word comes from the Latin "ordinalis" from which we get our English word "order". These weeks are set to a particular order, that is to say they are numbered.
