

## **TOP TEN PRIORITY REPAIRS**

In 2016, Hosanna celebrated as the “Burning with Faith” capital campaign paid off Hosanna’s mortgage debt! At this point, it became important to look at the physical repair needs of the church that had been postponed over time. An “Imagining the Possibilities” task force was appointed, led by Craig Jenkins, to determine a list of priority repair needs. These were brought to the congregation and approved by vote at a meeting on August 14, 2016.

Here are the top 10 priorities established by the task force:

- 1) Check integrity of the roof; inspect/repair as proposed by the roofer.
- 2) Lift station revisions to protect from lightning strikes.
- 3) Replace all light fixtures in the original building. Replace all light bulbs in the Fellowship Hall.
- 4) Remodel both restrooms in the original building.
- 5) Remodel the entire kitchen.
- 6) Recondition the Sanctuary.
- 7) Add tapering ramp/s for handicapped accessibility and add more handicapped parking spaces.
- 8) Install handicapped access doors for north and south side main entries.
- 9) Purchase additional chairs and tables for the new addition.
- 10) Paint the walls in all areas of the new building.

At that same August 14, 2016 congregational meeting, a Repair and Refurbishing (R & R) Fund was established as a designated fund to address these capital improvement needs until the top ten priorities have been met. These items will be addressed in order and will be taken care of only as funds become available to complete each project.

Steve Bridges was appointed by the Stewardship Team as the point person working to complete the Top Ten priority repairs.
