

Hosanna Disaster Relief Fund

Jon, thank you for your comments on Nov. 4th, 2017 regarding the Hosanna Disaster Relief Fund.

1.

Q-You asked if we feel that some sort of documentation should be required showing need

A-Our response –since Hosanna is a church, long documentations should not be required. Therefore we feel that the applicant should answer one simple question-How would the Hosanna Disaster Relief Fund help you recover from Hurricane Harvey. The answer should state the applicant's need. We anticipate that every recipient that has been determined to be of need, will receive the same monetary amount.

2.

Q-You asked should it denote on the form that someone is a re-applicant

A.-We feel that we would not know that a person was a re-applicant since it would be a blind application

3.

Q- You asked should there be a deadline established by which submissions would be made to enable you to see submissions as a group

A. A deadline should probably be established for the applicants for Harvey-

1. 30 days from date of approval of procedure by Hosanna Church Council
2. Follow up a deadline should probably be established for *re-applicants* for Harvey- Suggested time- 45 days from date of approval of procedure by Hosanna Church Council

Q- The applications will be given to the leaders of the finance and care teams for review.
