

Fall Immunization Clinic



Trina Williams is again offering a Fall Immunization Clinic at Hosanna on **Sept. 23rd from 9:00 am - 11:30**. She will offer regular flu, high dose flu for age 65 and older, Prevnar 13, and Shingrix for age 50 and older. Flu is usually covered for anyone on Medicare with the red, white and blue card. Shingrix is a 2 series vaccination - one now, one later.



Hosanna Book Club Members - The next session of the Hosanna Book discussion will be **Saturday, Sept. 29, at 5:00pm** in Classroom 5. The title is "**Bluebird, Bluebird**" by **Attica Locke**. This title is the Gulf Coast Reads selection for 2018. This is an award-winning mystery set along Route 59 in East Texas at the intersection of love, race, and justice. Hosanna's 7.0 Fitness Classes

This is a gentle fitness program for all interested adults. An important benefit is group fellowship and support. The program focuses on personal independence and helps improve strength, flexibility, balance, range of motion, and stamina. People with special needs, chronic illness, and limited strength or mobility, as well as those recovering from surgery, can benefit. **Classes continue on September 17, 20, and 24.** Classes are held on Mondays and Thursdays from 1:00 – 2:00 p.m. in the Fellowship Hall. **\$40/person; \$60/2 in same household; half price for half time – each term.** Clothing: Casual, loose-fitting; wear sneakers, if desired. Socks are recommended.

Bring: 3 bottles of water: 1 to drink; 2 for "weights" – OR 1# or 2# weights for the women and 2# or 3# weights for the men.
