

Knitters, Give This a Try:

Chemo Cap Knitting Directions

1 ball worsted weight yarn or fancy fur
Size 11 or 13 needles

Gauge: 10 st. = 12 rows = 4" stockinette stitch.

Cast on 32 (40) stitches

Row 1 & all odd rows, knit

Row 2 & all even rows.

If you are using double pointed needles then just knit.

Continue stockinette stitch until hat measures 6 (7) inches from beginning.

Row 1: *Knit 6 (8) stitches, knit 2 together; repeat from * to end = 28 (36) stitches.

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: *Knit 5 (7) stitches, knit 2 together; repeat from * to end = 24 (32) stitches.

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: *knit 4 (6) stitches, knit 2 together; repeat from * to end = 20 (28) stitches.

Row 6: *Purl 3 (5) stitches, purl 2 together; repeat from * to end = 16 (24) stitches.

Row 7: *Knit 2(4) stitches, knit 2 together; repeat from * to end = 12 (20) stitches.

Row 8: *Purl 1 (3) stitches, purl 2 together; repeat from * to end = 8 (16) stitches.

LARGE SIZE ONLY:

Row 9: *Knit 2; Knit 2 together; repeat from * to end = 12 stitches

Next round: *Purl 2 together; repeat from * to end = 4 (6) stitches.

Next round: *Knit 2 together; repeat from * to end = 2 (3) stitches.

Knit 2 (3) together and fasten off.

Cut yarn and leave a 8-12" tail to sew up seam.

Draw yarn tail through last remaining stitch using large eyed, blunt needle and tighten. Weave in ends.
