From The Pastor

The season of Lent begins earlier this year than last year because Easter is early this year. Easter is Sunday, April 1st, and since the date of Easter determines when Lent begins, Ash Wednesday is February 14. Again this year we will have the first service on Ash Wednesday, but the rest of the Lenten services will be on Thursday at 7pm.

Lent is a period of 40 days, not counting Sundays, during which we take special time to worship our Lord and remember His suffering, death, and resurrection for us and our salvation. Our sermons during the midweek services will be different than on our Sunday services again. The midweek services will deal with the seven last words of Christ from the cross.

The value of Lent can be summarized in this way. It is a time spent in meditation and prayer privately, as well as coming together to worship our God who loves us so much, He was willing to suffer and die for us. We do this for forty days because it reminds us of the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness fasting and being tempted by the devil. He withstood those temptations with the Word of God and so the use of the Word of God is key to the proper observance of Lent. Won't you use this time to learn more from God's Word, whether in worship, Bible Class, or privately? He is Your God and Lord and Savior. Love Him with all your heart, soul and mind.

A word about fasting during Lent. Fasting can be done in a variety of ways, like abstaining from something specific in your life. Food is usually associated with fasting, but it could include not watching movies or certain programs on TV. Abstaining from certain foods could be another way of fasting. The object of fasting is self discipline. For proper fasting and its purpose, refer to Jesus' words in Matthew 6:16-18. In the first part of that section of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus speaks about various pious practices.





As many may have noticed, Ash Wednesday is February 14th. Also known as Valentine's day – that day when couples of all ages express their affection for one another in various ways. So, the question before us, the children of God, is this: Is it possible to simultaneously observe the day of celebration of love with that of sacrifice and sorrow over sin?

Perhaps, thinking of Lent and Valentine's Day together, it would be possible for us to remember that love, true Godly love, requires willing and obedient sacrifice. And as we have been saved by the love of God the Father in Christ Jesus His Son, our lives ought to be characterized by that same kind of love.

Whatever it is that one chooses to give up and sacrifice for Lent, let it be done out of a heart filled with love; not out of a heart of begrudging duty. After all, as the called and chosen people of God we are commanded to live a life of Godly love. This is the kind of love that can and is only found in God Himself. This is that *agape* love that many of us so often hear about. This is the kind of love that gives and gives of itself, regardless of how the object of that affection acts or responds to it.

From cover to cover, the Bible oozes with God's unending, untiring, and unfailing sacrificial love to mankind. And ultimately, He lovingly made the greatest sacrifice of all by sending His Son Jesus to die on the cross. And, the price Jesus paid for my sin, for your sin, and the sin of all mankind, He did out of love.

Many of us know John 3:16. This Bible verse has been called "The Gospel in a nutshell. And, how true that is. But in his epistle, John is inspired by the Holy Spirit to write these words which help us understand why we, the children of God, can display this same sacrificial *agape* love: "Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent His Son to be the perfect satisfaction and complete sacrifice for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another...We love Him because He first loved us" (I John 4:10-11, 19).

So this year, may we all follow the example of our Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ our Lord by willingly sacrifice and give of ourselves, no matter how much or how little, no matter the cost, for the sake of that true *agape* love in order that souls would be saved and the Kingdom of Heaven enriched.
