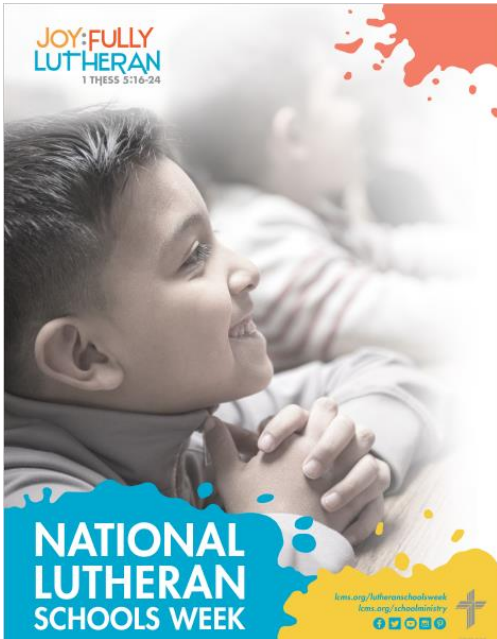
Enrollment Updates:
