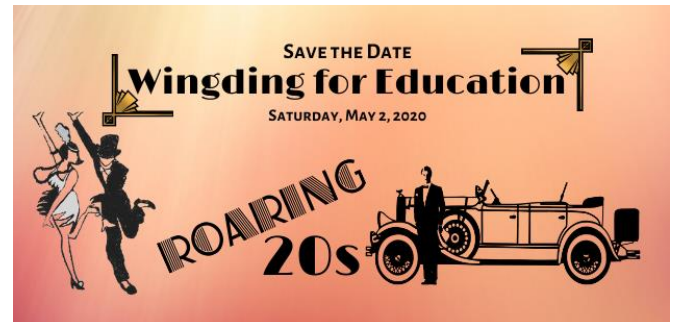

FEED MY STARVING CHILDREN

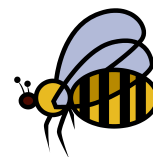
This organization was started in 1987 by businessmen who wanted to feed the starving children around the world. It is a non-profit agency.
