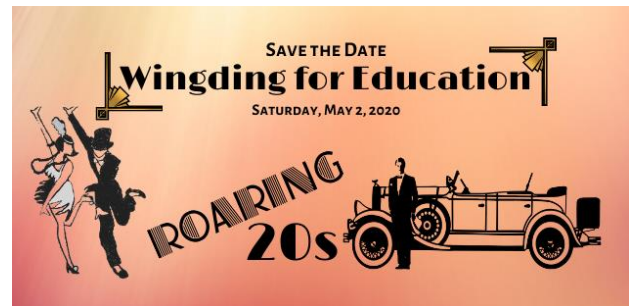
God's blessings to the 4-6 grade basketball teams as they compete in tournaments this weekend. A bracket for each has been attached to the memo.

FEED MY STARVING CHILDREN

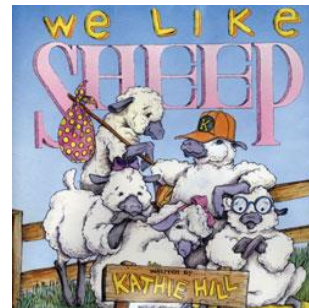
This organization was started in 1987 by businessmen who wanted to feed the starving children around the world. It is a non-profit agency.
